Distribution Guidelines

- **Submission Dates:** (Optionally send it out either Friday 10/10 or Monday 10/12, NOT BOTH). First Send should be Wednesday 10/15 (3 Days Before), Friday 10/17 (the Day Before), and Saturday 10/18 (Day Of). We recommend "schedule sending" it before 8 AM your local time.
- Direct Email: Send the media advisory directly to the email contacts of trusted reporters and newsrooms. Make sure to put their email addresses into the BCC line if you are mass emailing. Email 15-20 email addresses at a time.
- "Submit A Tip": In addition to emailing direct contacts, make sure to submit the media advisory through the "Submit A Tip" or "Contact Us" form on local news websites. Many newsrooms monitor these submissions regularly for potential stories
- **Follow Up:** After sending the advisory, follow up with key contacts to confirm receipt and answer any questions. We would suggest calling the local TV stations.
- **Post-Action Press Release**: Prepare a press release to celebrate your successful protest. Send it on the morning of October 19th if all goes well.
