Yet this isn't the case: so why is it okay to eat other animals but not ourselves? Plenty of other animals - chickens, hamsters, polar bears, rabbits- eat their own species. Even chimpanzees, which humans share 99% of their DNA with, eat other chimpanzees. The fact that our closest DNA relative does so surely suggests that cannibalism is a part of human nature that should be indulged in. Regardless, there is a strong stigma surrounding cannibalism, as well as many legal obstacles that prevent the practice from occurring.

Because of our human ability to empathize and connect with other people, we don't want to eat the people we know. However, these connections are made on a personal level and aren't replicated in everyone. Take, for example, the social constructivism surrounding eating dogs. Western cultures condemn the consumption of dog meat, as many households own dogs as house pets. It is a result of this emotional connection to the species that many people shiver at the thought of eating a dog. However, the act of eating dog meat is commonplace in many countries, including China, Vietnam, Nigeria, and even Switzerland. This example is an illustration of how emotion prevents (most) people from wanting to eat human meat. We don't want to kill and eat something that we love- or have been happy with- doing so would result in negative emotions like guilt, sadness, or regret. But while it would be understandable to not want to eat someone you know, why do we abstain from eating humans entirely?

I want you to use your imagination: It's 7pm, after a long day at work, and you are browsing the aisles of a grocery store. It's a breakfast-for-dinner kind of night. In your basket lay bananas from Costa Rica, pre-made waffles from Belgium, and a vat of whipped cream from who-knows-where. The last two items on your list: bacon and eggs. While scanning the butcher's display cases, you might feel a twinge of negative emotions (sadness, guilt, or regret) looking at all the meat, but it's only for a fleeting moment. As you walk to the register, you grab a pack of eggs- locally and sustainably raised! Nice! Surely, this scene is familiar to anyone who has been to a grocery store. We like to think that we know where our food is coming from, and understand what we are eating. But this is far from reality for most of us. The average grocery store in the US offers nearly 39,000 different products. Being offered such an overwhelmingly large amount of stuff means that we put very little thought into what we are buying, other than if we want to eat it. We simply look at the label- from Costa Rica? Belgium? Locally made?- and move on with indifference. Now let's replace bacon with human in our hypothetical story. Would our grocery store habits really change? Many people don't go vegetarian, as "(insert product with meat) is just so good!". I believe this attitude would remain the same even if it was regarding human meat. Some people might feel a twinge of hesitation or sadness, but will ultimately proceed with their purchase as the satisfaction of a good meal, and reward of positive emotion from eating it, is worth it.

Many religions, as well as governments, have rules that are directly against cannibalism, or make it much harder to do. Having faith means that most people either believe that cannibalism is wrong, because it isn't supported in their religion, or that they are committed to following laws that prevent cannibalism from occurring. The largest reason that cannibalism is condemned is because it requires the death of a human who will then be consumed. Murdering humans is strongly advised against in most religions, as well as considered a criminal offence in many countries. As a result of this, there is no legal way to 'farm' human

meat, even if it replicated the industrialized processes used to produce cow, pig, or chicken meat. But is following our faith blinding us in this context?

As stated earlier, many other animals consume their own species. The global consumption of meat by humans is continuing to increase over time, yet eating ourselves is still shunned. Doesn't it seem hypocritical that most societies condemn cannibalism but support the consumption of meat? Many people would argue that eating each other is bad because it means people are dying for your personal satisfaction- and this argument makes sense.
