

I have a Tern Overland Electric Roof Hatch, and I'd like to replace it with the new Manual Roof Hatch. Is the manual version a direct replacement?

While the 2025 and newer manual roof hatch shares the same 500mm x700mm base dimensions, there are some installation considerations:

- The corner radii are different between the models, with the manual version having a tighter corner radius of 50mm. If your existing cut hole opening exceeds the recommended 503mmx703mm spec, there may be an unsupported gap under the glue channel around the corners, and the roof hatch may leak.
- The discontinued electric roof hatches could accommodate roof thicknesses from 42mm to 80mm. The new manual roof hatch can accommodate a roof thickness between 25mm and 60mm.
