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Rules

Content

1. **Only add official information:** Any media has more than enough information that you may need for creating an article. Do not make stuff up and especially do not add things that have nothing to do with the character in question. That said we allow taking things at face value, fan-theories and mass guessing can go into a separate trivia section.
2. **No articles on upcoming media/leaked info:** Do not create an article on villains from upcoming media, be it movies, games or anything else. Not only this could figure huge spoilers, but we also would never be able to determine the veracity of the information on such pages which could be nothing more than speculation. As a general rule, you should wait a few days, at least a week since release before creating an article.
3. **No "One-line" articles:** There is just no excuse for laziness. Articles with little to no content (only a single paragraph or just a picture without any text) will be deleted if not expanded. If a user only makes articles like this he/she will be warned. An article must at the very least have an introduction line and a complete paragraph resuming the character to be considered a stub. Simply adding a Stub or Construction template on the page will not prevent it from being marked as a One-Line Article, by the way. A page will be marked as a One-Line within a day if not expanded, abusing the template will also result in a warning and possible ban (at the admins discretion) in case of repeated offense. Also do not remove the One-Line Article warning without actually expanding the page.
4. **No Fanfiction:** This wiki is for legitimate villains from every existing media. We will not be accepting "demonized" characters and/or characters which only exist as random image macros around the internet, basically anything that does not have a story/plot

attached to it and enough to differ it from other works that it can pass most parody laws (YouTube videos, Fan-games and Creepypasta ARE NOT exempt to these rules, just so you know). If you have questions about a particular character, CONTACT AN ADMINISTRATOR.

5. **Original Web Content**: For the sake of variety we will accept villains from original web content that is NOT OF YOUR OWN CREATION. To count, the character in question must have some level of fame/infamy, for example: for YouTube videos/series, a minimum 500k views on average and/or at least 100k subscribers, or multiple references on other sources. The same goes for Webcomics and original Creepypasta characters. The character must also have a plot/backstory attached to it, as per the above rule.
6. **No Troll/Exploitation Stuff**: An addendum to the above two rules, from now on articles on YouTube movies/webseries that are nothing but troll or exploitation stuff will be forbidden, no exceptions. Again, when in doubt CONTACT AN ADMINISTRATOR.
7. **No Articles on Minor Enemies/Generic Thugs**: Please, you do not have to make an article on every single enemy which appears on a game, the gaming Wikis exist for that. Instead, we will limit our articles to organizations, named villains and plot-relevant boss characters. In short, do NOT add numerous pages for a single enemy when it would save time and space by merging them into a single article.
8. **No Real-Life People**: Our wiki focuses exclusively on fictional villains. Articles found about real-life villains will get deleted on sight.

Skipping 9 and 10.

11. **Antagonistic Scale**: Abuse of the antagonistic scale, or as it is otherwise called "antagonist fussing" is frowned upon here. Conflicting over the scale (e.g. "main/secondary/tertiary antagonist, true main antagonist") falls under edit warring and will not be tolerated. To reduce such edit warring, labels such as "true/hidden main antagonist", "main later secondary antagonist" or "tertiary antagonist" and anything below that is strictly prohibited and will be reverted on sight. Adding analyses over antagonist labels such as "this villain is thought to be the main antagonist, but is actually the secondary antagonist" into trivia sections is also prohibited, as this does nothing but clog up pages with messy information that solely discusses something as minor as a villain's antagonist label. 12. **Similarity Comparisons on Unrelated Works**: While comparing villains of the same franchise or mentioning a character is a parody/homage is fine we do not allow random comparisons to outside work especially superficial similarities.

Show Villains

[Satan \(The Bible\)](#)



Satan is the main antagonist in the 2013 The History Channel miniseries The Bible.

He was portrayed by Mohamen Medhi Ouazzani.

Biography

Satan first appeared to Jesus Christ near the end of his 40-day journey in the desert. He appeared as an older male in a dark cloak. He had long, dark fingernails. At this point Jesus was exhausted, hungry, and thirsty. Recognizing that Jesus was at his most vulnerable, Satan attempts to turn the Son of God away from his mission to redeem mankind.

Satan first asked Jesus to prove His divinity by turning a rock into a loaf of bread. Jesus refused to take the bait, however, and replied that man does not live by bread alone. He then took Jesus up to a high pinnacle and showed Him all the kingdoms of the world, offering to give them to Him in return for his worship. Satan then showed Jesus a vision of sitting in a throne room, with [Pontius Pilate](#) washing his feet for him.

Unmoved, Jesus told Satan to be gone, and that He worshiped God alone. Satan then left Jesus alone in the desert.

Satan later appeared during the judgment of Jesus Christ, watching as the Jewish and Roman authorities put Him to death.

When the parts of the miniseries featuring Jesus Christ were adapted into the film [Son of God](#), the scenes featuring Ouazanni were left out of the film. This was due to the producers feeling that this version of Satan distracted too much from the story.

Trivia

- This version of Satan became a point of controversy due to his resemblance to US President [Barack Obama](#). Both the History Channel and the producers of the show denied any connection. [Roma Downey](#) and [Mark Burnett](#) pointed out that Ouazanni had played parts in other biblical epics, including Satanic characters, well before Obama was elected.

[Neo-Grifforzer](#)



Neo-Grifforzer is an evil "embodiment clone" created by [Space War God Borudosu](#) and one of the two secondary antagonists in the film *Zyuden Sentai Kyoryuger vs. Go-Busters: Dinosaur Great Battle! Farewell, Eternal Friends*.

Not the original [Grifforzer](#) (who was sealed away with [Witch Bandora](#) after the final defeat of [Dai Satan](#)), he is an evil embodiment of the regret of the Bandora Gang in their failure to defeat the Zyurangers in the past.

History

Neo-Grifforzer and his partner [Neo-Geildon](#) were created by Space War God Borudosu for the purpose of gathering enough Dino Hope to revive it. They were joined by resurrected [Vaglass](#) members [Enter](#) and [Escape](#), who had been revived due to a Vaglass restoration program activated by Borudosu.

Neo-Grifforzer and Neo-Geildon brainwashed Tyranno Ranger and AbaRed of the Zyurangers and Abarangers respectively to serve them. However, they were later freed by the power of Dino Hope.

He was later defeated when the Kyoryugers combined their powers with the Zyurangers and Abarangers to create the Ultimate Howling Cannon and used it to destroy Neo-Grifforzer.

[Associate Professor Evil](#)



Associate Professor Evil is one of the prominent characters of Brandon "Oxhorn" Dennis' series of World of Warcraft machinimas. He is also known as Mr. Evil, and has an alter-ego known as Lieutenant Colonel Virtue.

Biography

He was sent to the Evil Alchemist University by his parents so that he might become the most evil alchemist ever. He studied hard while he was there, and didn't have much of a social life. All of his friends dropped out and are now selling cheese or cockroaches in the Undercity, but Associate Professor Evil graduated with honors, and now works at the Evil Alchemist University, instructing students in evil alchemy.

In order to maintain his reputation, he must be constantly pursuing evil... pursuits. He has decided that he wants a lot of power, and has concocted a number of schemes in order to get such power. He and his pet crab named Barnaby travel all over Azeroth, when he is not teaching, in order to find new ways of attaining evil power. Instead, Associate Professor Evil ends up solving some social ill, which forces many to ask whether or not he is truly evil at all.

Commie



Commie is one of the main characters in the YouTube series Centricide created by Jreg. He is the embodiment of Left Authoritarianism and a member of the Extremists.

He is portrayed by Greg Guevara who also portrays every other character in the series.

Personality

Commie is very intellectual, but very aggressive. He speaks very poised and proud when discussing his nuanced understanding of politics. He bickers a lot with [Nazi](#) and [AnCap](#) but is

good friends with [AnCom](#) despite their differences (it may be implied that they have romantic feelings for each other).

Biography

In "Meet the Extremists", Commie introduces himself as "real communist". He is against Centrists as he is sick of people calling the left liberals and is willing to work with the other Extremes to eliminate them.

In "Conservatives, Socialists, Progressives and Libertarians", he kills Socialist for refusing to join them. After that in Progressive lands he kills Progressive and saves AnCom from Ape Political whom he kills although AnCom turns into Post-Left and leaves the Extremes. Commie is deeply upset by this.

In "Neoliberalism", AnCap asks Commie whether or not he is bad. Commie laughs and tells him that he is the worst of the Extremes.

In "Horseshoe Theory", Commie and Nazi fight team up to fight Horseshoe Centrist, who easily defeats them. The two reluctantly summon [Nazbol](#) to defeat Horseshoe Centrist.

Video Game Villains

[Kevin \(Egg Kevin's House\)](#)



Kevin is the titular main antagonist of the Roblox short horror game Egg Kevin's House, serving as the main antagonist of the Pacifist Ending and the Warmonger Ending and the deuteragonist of the Team Kevin Ending and the Rescued Ending.

Biography

Kevin first appeared during the game's introduction, explaining the cause of his villainy. One day, after getting in trouble because of Kevin, Billy brings Sam (The Player) to throw eggs at his house for payback. Despite being reluctant, he accepts. But as they threw eggs at Kevin's house, they accidentally hit a candle down, setting the house on fire and killing Kevin's mother

in the process. Kevin then arrives to his house and notices that it had burned down, making him devastated.

20 years later, he kidnapped Steven, one of Sam and Billy's friends, and took him inside his basement. As they notice Steven's headphones on the ground, they are both knocked out by an unknown stranger, who is later revealed to be Kevin himself. He explains to Sam and Billy the reason behind his actions, revealing that he is doing all of this simply to avenge the death of his mother, who died during the house fire. In hopes of completing his revenge, he sets the basement on fire in an attempt to kill both Billy and Sam, but they manage to escape.

Confronting him outside, Sam is given the choice of either killing Kevin or sparing him. If Kevin is spared, he will tell both Sam and Billy that he may have failed his revenge, but vows that one day, they will both be dead and justice will be served.

If the player doesn't rescue Billy from the fire and instead waits until the screen goes black, Kevin will take them to the hospital. In a final message, he tells Sam that the monster who killed his mother was finally gone, before telling him to never see him again.

If Kevin is killed, Sam will be chased by the authorities for the murder of both of his friends.

Trivia

- Ironically, Kevin's villainous actions were done for the purpose of justice, because the house fire and his mother's death were both directly caused by Billy, even if it was by accident.

[Unbaptized Babies \(Dante's Inferno\)](#)

Overview

The Unbaptized Babies were babies which passed away until they could be baptized like a miscarriage and stillborn children, condemning them to Limbo. They are gray-skinned, deformed, haunted demonic versions of their former egos, glowing eyes, and scars all around their eyes and body as if they are stitched simultaneously. Their umbilical cord is twisted around the body. Their most notable trait is that they have, being armless, bony and razor-sharp blades instead. Due to their age and height, they are very easy to be defeated.

Trivia

- The Unbaptized Babies prompted controversy with the International Nanny Association, due to the "Bad Nanny" achievement/trophy.

[Tim \(Braid\)](#)



Tim is the villainous main protagonist of the puzzle platform video game Braid, and it's upcoming special edition. He is a man searching for a princess who "has been snatched by a horrible and evil monster", only it is revealed in the end that he himself is actually the monster she is talking about.

Biography

At the beginning of the game Tim is shadowed outside his house.

In the true ending, Tim catches up to the princess through the rewinding of the chandelier which resulted in her exploding and annihilating all life, except for his own.

The Skibidi Toilets are the titular main antagonistic faction of the webseries *Skibidi Toilet* and of the videogame *Skibidi War - Toilets Attack*. They are a species of living toilets with human heads.

Overview

The Skibidi Toilets are all characterized by being living toilets (with the exception of the Skibidi Urinals and the Three-Headed Skibidi Bathtub) with human heads. Despite most of them lacking limbs, they're able to move regardless of that.

The Skibidi Toilets are characterized by their personal anthem (which is actually a mix of the songs "Give It To Me" by Timbaland and "Dom Dom Yes Yes" by Fiki Chupki V Krista), which they continuously sing and seems to be the only thing they're able to say.

Skibidi Toilets are pretty durable but they can be killed by things such as bullets and explosions. An easy way to kill them, however, is flushing them.

The Skibidi Toilets come in many different variants. For the sake of simplicity, they can be divided into the following categories (note that some of these categories can often overlap):

- Normal Skibidi Toilets - The basic variant with no particular features.
- Smaller and bigger Skibidi Toilets - Skibidi Toilets that are either smaller or bigger than the normal ones.
- Modified and bio-engineered Skibidi Toilets - Skibidi Toilets that have either gone through modifications of varying degrees to become more fearsome combat units, or have been artificially created.
- Skibidi Urinals - Members of the species who, instead of being toilets, are urinals.
- Skibidi Bathtubs - Members of the species who, instead of being toilets, are bathtubs.

[Ashfur \(Mary On A Cross\)](#)



Ashfur is the villainous protagonist of [Mary On A Cross](#), a Warrior Cats AU multi animator project hosted by [tootall buggy](#). He Was a ThunderClan warrior who tried to kill his ex-mate's kits by lighting the forest on fire, though this backfired when he was crushed by a burning tree. Some years later, his spirit came back to possess Bramblestar, after which he killed Squirrelflight before getting killed himself.

Biography

Ashfur was a ThunderClan warrior in love with his Clanmate Squirrelflight, often admiring her when the two would go hunting together. However, Squirrelflight ultimately chose Brambleclaw as her mate over him, leaving Ashfur enraged with heartbreak. When Squirrelflight and Brambleclaw adopt Leafpool's kits - Hollykit, Jaykit and Lionkit - his anger and sadness only increases.

One day, when the kits are older, Ashfur storms out of camp after angrily watching Squirrelflight and Brambleclaw play with them. While out in the forest, he finds a burning branch, picking it up and running back to camp with it. He uses it to set the whole camp on fire, and though most of the Clan escapes, Squirrelflight and her kits are trapped inside. Ashfur then confronts her,

blocking the exit while singing to her threateningly. As the orange she-cat yells at him, he taunts her, causing her to slash him across the face, leaving a large gash on his snout.

Skipping ahead.

During the commotion, Bramblestar suddenly passes out, interrupting the argument and drawing everyone's attention. As the gather around the leader's body, Ashfur's spirit enters it, and Bramblestar's eyes fade from yellow and orange to red and blue. Now possessing the leader, Ashfur gets up and immediately tackles Squirrelflight, pinning her down. Not yet realizing something's wrong with her mate, she smiles and gets up to hug him, which he's uncomfortable with. Angered by this, he bites into her right shoulder. As she backs away in fear, Ashfur sings to her in the same way he had during the fire, causing her to realize that he is possessing Bramblestar. Ashfur then grabs her by the scruff with his teeth, tossing her off the highrock.

Squirrelflight dies on impact as her family watches in horror, and as everyone rushes to her body, Ashfur runs out of camp. Hollyleaf sees this and runs after him, following him to the lake. There, Ashfur looks into the water and sees Bramblestar's reflection fade into his own, sighing. Hollyleaf then ambushes him from behind, killing Bramblestar's body with a bite to the throat.

During the credits, Ashfur is seen having been ejected from Bramblestar's now dead body, and now wanders the Dark Forest. He then runs into the spirit of Hawkfrost, a RiverClan warrior he'd conspired with in life to try and kill Firestar, in a failed attempt to make Squirrelflight suffer. He's surprised to see Hawkfrost, who turns to him and gives a menacing grin.

Stewie Griffin (Real World Universe)

Stewart Gilligan Griffin, better known as Stewie Griffin, is one of the two secondary antagonists (alongside Baron Mordo) of the Real World Universe.

He is a variant of the original [Stewie Griffin](#) who although not a Marvel character, was extracted to the Real World by [K.E.V.I.N.](#) who wanted to use him to capture both [She-Hulk](#) and [M.O.D.O.K.](#), however Stewie escaped before K.E.V.I.N. could finish his explanation and was recruited into the Council of Fictionals by Baron Mordo. Despite his initial loyalty, Stewie would betray M.O.D.O.K. and the Fictionals after the latter refused to help him extract Brian Griffin from the Family Guy Universe, and began cloning an army of himself to begin conquering the Real World, which put him up against The Saviors, a group of extracted and displaced Marvel heroes and anti-heroes, as well as being hunted down by Baron Mordo numerous times.

[Rainbow Dash \(Rainbow.EXE\)](#)



Rainbow Dash, later known as Rainbow Dash.EXE, is the titular main antagonist of the My Little Pony creepypasta horror game Rainbow.EXE, made by J.B.M.

She is a version of Rainbow Dash who was possessed by Sonic.EXE in the first level of the game and became a serial killer who goes on a killing spree to avenge those who tortured her in the past, with the experiments, the tests, the cupcakes and the games.

Biography

Beginning

Rainbow Dash is first seen flying in the sky, while nothing strange is going on. However, the setting becomes much more sinister, with the sky turning black and the clouds glitching up, which she dodges. Eventually, she comes across Sonic.EXE, who tells her that her whole life was a lie and offers her to have revenge on the ones who made her life such a nightmare, like the events surrounding the experiments, the cupcakes, the test and the games. To achieve her revenge, Sonic.EXE tasks her with killing the ponies in order to despawn them and avoid them respawning in order to free their souls in order to see the lie of their existence. Rainbow Dash is then possessed by the demonic hedgehog as she screams, giving her a new, demonic appearance.

Betraying Sonic.EXE

As soon as the new game begins, the now-possessed Rainbow Dash encounters one of the Cutie Mark Crusaders, Scootaloo, and strangles her with her claw that she hides under her lightning-shaped wound while restraining her with her magic before stabbing her neck with the claw, killing her. Sonic.EXE realizes what she is doing and notices that she is trying to turn her into an EXE, which is not how the plan was planned in the first place, which is freeing them. Sonic.EXE then warns that if she doesn't do what she is supposed to do, he would murder her. However, Rainbow Dash.EXE then betrays Sonic.EXE as she yells about having enough of him using her to take control of Hasbro and wants to handle the job on her own, which causes Sonic.EXE to disconnect. She then mentions that all she wants is revenge and control as well as being free, not being used by someone to help them achieve complete control instead of her. She then notices the player, telling them that they are not a program and is therefore free, but they are playing a game. She then orders them to play with her, as she resets the game.

Killing Spree

As Pinkie Pie was walking around during the night, she comes across Rainbow Dash, who pins her to the ground and stabs her torso with a stake. She then electrocutes her to death with her powers, breaking the game as she turns into an EXE, causing her to reset the game again. Fluttershy, alone in the landscape, walks around until she encounters her rabbit tied on a streetlight, which then reveals it as a trap as Rainbow Dash appears and kills her pet, causing Fluttershy to scream in pain as she is then electrocuted by black lightning along with the dead rabbit. She is then transformed into an EXE like Pinkie Pie, as the game resets once more.

Rainbow Dash and her slaves then stalk Twilight Sparkle from behind as she walks around, not noticing their presence. Rainbow Dash then ambushes Twilight Sparkle and restrains her with her magic horn, before strangling her to death, as she is then turned into one of her slaves, breaking the game again, causing it to reset for the 6th time.

Rainbow Dash then goes on to take down Rarity as her next victim. She then stalks her like she did to the other ponies as she walks through the dark scenery, eventually coming across a statue, who seems to be immobile. However, as Rarity walks further, the statue rushes towards her from behind, allowing Rainbow Dash to approach her and stab her spine with a iron stake, before she manipulators with her magic horn as she forces her to grab a pair of scissors and stab herself in the neck, yelling in pain before dying and becoming the second-to last slave of Rainbow Dash.EXE.

Final Game and Ending

After killing five of her former friends, she decides to find the final victim, Apple Jack, who is at her barn. Apple jack eventually notices Rainbow Dash.EXE floating above her as she attempts to attack her by rushing to the right and to the left to kick her, but she fails due to Rainbow Dash not being in front or behind her. As she was about to kill her, however, she starts to feel remorseful for her actions, reducing herself to tears as she remembers the joyful pony she was before, seemingly sparing Apple Jack, but she actually causes the side of the screen to close on itself, crushing the orange pony to death as she becomes the final slave of Rainbow Dash.EXE. The game then restarts for the final time.

As soon as the player starts the game for the final time, Rainbow Dash.EXE causes the title screen to slowly disappear into nothing but a black void, as she then presses against the screen and stares straight towards the player, before shattering the screen and shutting down their game to get inside the player's computer, denying access to the Task Manager to not let them escape. As the player opens the game once more, Rainbow Dash.EXE greets them to nothing but static as she shows images of her demonic self, before telling the player that her and her slaves are now real and that they can't stop her, as she then pops up in front of them and forces the game shut, changing their desktop wallpaper, where she tells the player that the end is neigh, as she has fully taken control of the player's entire computer, still denying access to the Task Manager.

If the player decides to open the game again, Rainbow Dash.EXE will force them to play with her. They will then be greeted with a screen resembling the "Fun is Infinite, SEGA Enterprises" easter egg from Sonic CD, with pictures of a bloody, insane Rainbow Dash all around the screen, as slowed down music plays in the background.

Irate Gamer



Biography:

Irate Gamer is a major member of the Subspace Army; the others are Dr. Robotnik, Hitler, Mary, Bison, Dr. Wily, Carlos Trejo, and Xerxes. He is first seen in the Real City, where he uses a Dark Cannon to trophy the AVGN when the AVGN is fighting against the Nostalgia Critic. The Critic misses IG with his gun, but IG retaliates by summoning the Game Genie to trophy the Critic. Later, Ganondorf grants permission from IG to send a Subspace Bomb to engulf the city. The Irate Gamer speeds away on his bike after he summoned the Game Genie, oblivious to the tracks he produced. This leads to the second encounter with the Nostalgia Critic, but this time, the Critic brings some recruits. Panicking, the IG asks for assistance from Ganondorf, who sends Robotnik's and Xerxes's minions to stop the heroes. The cowardly IG hides in a bush and creates a Shadow Bug copy of himself while the real IG plans out a new strategy. The copy trophies the Nostalgia Critic and creates a shadow clone of him. He then fights Tommy Wiseau and Madotsuki, along with the real Critic. However, the Critic laughs at the IG clone, thinking that the fight's going to be a cakewalk, until the clone gained more shadow bugs and tripled in

Frederick the Terrible

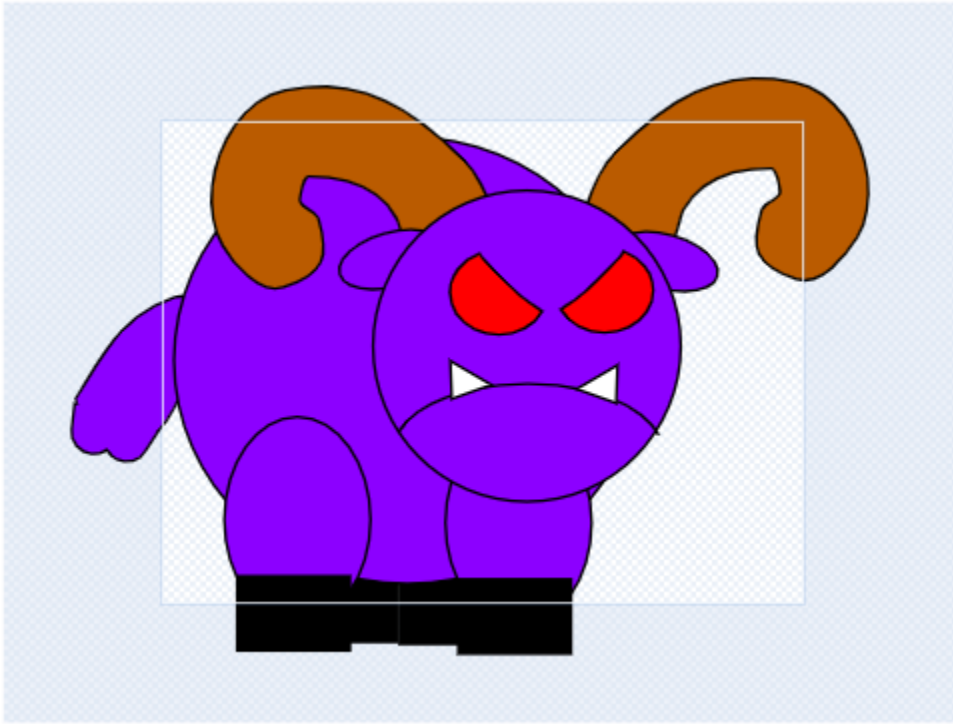


Frederick the Terrible is a crab dictator who has a magic staff.
