

## 2023 FCCGE Ambassador Garden Watering Protocols and Sign-up

I have created a Google Spreadsheet we can use to sign up and share coverage of tasks for our Ambassador Garden. Right now, watering is our focus. Please see the link below. We do not need to tend the garden daily at this point. It would be great if we rotate through watering the garden every other day while it is not raining. There may be some rain this weekend, but the next couple weeks are likely to continue our dry spell. Try to sign up at least once every two weeks so we share the work. Place an "X" on the day you can spend an hour watering.

We noticed that the beds dried out very quickly with the planting material we were given. Nancy added some organic bedding mix to the top and laid out soaking hoses. You will use the black cloth covered hose on the left when you look at the spigot. Turn the black lever to open as shown after you turn the spigot on. The spigot is a little unusual with several hoses attached. Ignore the other two.

You can control the flow of water with the black lever at the end of the hose. Use it to connect to the soaker hose in each bed.

Nancy anticipates that it will take 30 minutes per bed to soak them well. You may want to bring a book :)

We will leave a watering can so you can water the table top raised planter that is on the cement pad.
