



Making Basic Gun Shots

First, you need to:

1. Create a new project folder called "Gun Shot Tutorial"
 2. Inside that, create a new folder called "Media-Gun Shot Tutorial"
 3. In Premiere Pro, make a new project (File>New Project)
 4. Save your New Project in your "Gun Shot Tutorial" folder.

Items that I will be looking for:

- 1. Gun shot is in sync with the hand movement**
- 2. Muzzle flash is only one frame long & placed in correct spot**
- 3. Smoke is added properly**
- 4. Linear dodge (Add) is part of the shot --one frame**
- 5. Sound matches the recoil of the hand & gun.**
