The beginning of the paragraph juts out to the right by aligning left and right. The length of the introduction ranges from 1000-1500 words consisting of research background, grounded Theory, relevant previous research, formulation and reference list. Avoid critical and bombastic sentences. The header lists the name of the Journal of Citizenship, Volume and Number, Month and Year of publication, as well as P-ISSN Numbers: and E-ISSN: using the letters Cambria (Headings) Bold size 12 pt and in blue jutting out on the right side. While the Footer contains the page on the right, as well as the name of the author and the origin of the agency. If the author consists of 2 people just use the &. If the author is more than 2 people simply list et al. And if the three are different agencies, just the first author's agency is listed.

The introduction begins (briefly, e.g. maximum 1 paragraph) the general background of the study; it should then contain the State of The Art (a review of the literature review or previous research2 briefly, 1-2 paragraphs) with the aim of justifying/corroborating the novelty statement or the significance or scientific contribution or originality of this article and try to have a reference to the article from the journal of the last 10 years that reinforces the justification of such originality or contribution); Before writing the objectives of the study, there must be a Gap Analysis or statement of gaps (originality) or a statement of novelty contribution (novelty statement) clearly and explicitly, or a unique difference of this study compared to previous studies, as well as from the important side of whether the research was carried out; only then did the research objectives in this article be written in a straightforward and clear manner.

RESEARCH METHODS

The research method used is Qualitative Research with types of research including: Descriptive Studies, Literacy Studies, Case Studies, Phenomenology, Ethnography, Narrative, Mix Method. While quantitative research methods can be in the form of surveys, correlational, and experimental. Class Action Research is carried out a maximum of 3 cycles, consisting of planning, implementation, observation, and reflection. Data collection techniques must be described in detail such as observation, documentation, interviews, questionnaires, questionnaires which are also supported by relevant references.

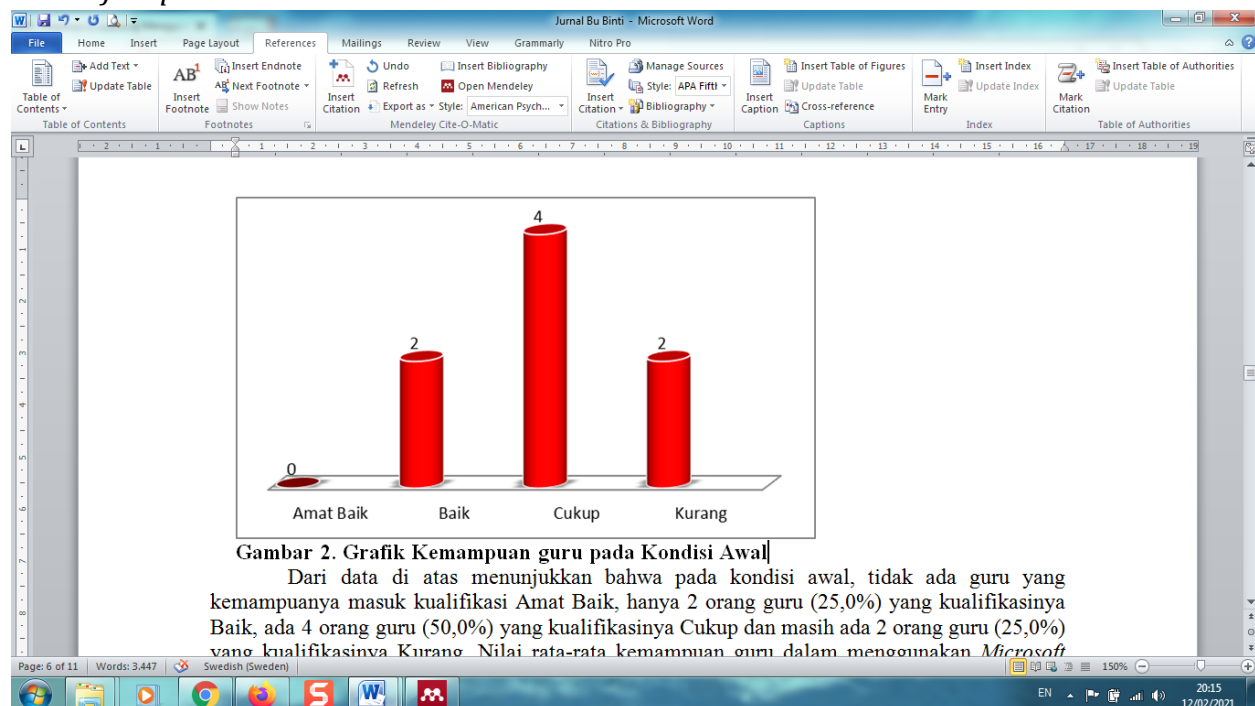


Figure 1. Graph of Teacher Ability in Initial Conditions

Discussion

The discussion contains the results of research and its discussion scientifically. The discussion contains an explanation of the regulations and about the facts. Analysis according to the approach of the problem chosen by the author. In addition, it should also be explained its comparison with the results of other researchers who are almost the same topic. The results of the research and findings must be able to answer the formulation of the research problem in the introduction. Use references that are factual and relevant. The article is obliged to produce novelty or novelty both from the theoretical side and from the practitioner side.

The Discussion at least contains: (1)(what/how element) whether the data presented has been processed (not raw data), poured in the form of a table or figure (choose one), and captioned that is easy to understand? Write down the findings, but don't discuss them here; (2). (why element) in the discussion section, there is a relationship between the results obtained and the basic concepts and / or hypotheses. In some fields of science, they even have to discuss up to the level of studying molecular aspects. The discussions made must be supported by real and clear facts; and (3) (what else element) whether there is conformity or opposition to the results of other people's research.

We do not tolerate actions that smear academic marwah such as plagiarism (maximum 20% when checked using Turnitin),

CONCLUSION

Conclusions must answer the problem coherently. There is no need to make points but simply with a paragraph model. No longer citing references. In the conclusions it is necessary to convey the shortcomings in this study and suggestions for future research. Conclusions are only enough to answer the problem or research objectives, or can also produce a new theory / concept based on existing facts / analysis; Don't be impressed with discussing it again in the Conclusion section. A thank you please be included in the last paragraph and not excessive, just mention the parties involved in the research such as funders/sponsors, LPPM, supervisors, etc.

BIBLIOGRAPHY (APA Format/ American Psychological Association 7th Edition)

The currentity of the reference library, especially those used to justify originality or novelty (in the Introduction) should be the last 10 years. The priority of reference library literature, try to make a minimum of 80 percent come from primary literature / scientific journals Referrals should be encouraged from reputable international journals or accredited national scientific journals, not from books or anything else.

The bibliography uses single spacing, aligned left and right, the second line section jutting out to the right. After 0 before 0. Cambria (Headings) size 12 pt.

Bibliography may come from books, mass media, and the Act. It is mandatory to use mendeley, zotero, endnote, etc.

Authors are expected to cite articles in the Journal of Citizenship in the previous volume or cite the articles of our reviewers.

There is no need to separate the sources of books, articles, and Laws. Must not use https:// website address/ blog
