Nvivo lab assignment: coding basics II - Initial, axial, focused codes



General instructions

For this assignment, <u>you will analyze the "education responses" data</u> and create codes.

Assignment instructions

- 1. Think about the general themes in three levels: (1) initial coding (create around 20-25 codes in this stage), (2) axial coding (categorize those 20-25 initial codes into 7-10 axial codes in this stage), and (3) focused coding (categorize those 7-10 axial codes into 3-4 focused codes)
- Provide a list of your codes and themes (screenshot of your codes view in Nvivo, expand all the branches). Now write a paragraph about the perspectives of online vs. in-person classes in at least 300 words by using your axial and focused codes.

Save the Project

1. On the File tab, click Save.

Copy the Project File to your Google Drive

- 1. Go to https://drive.google.com/
- Click New Folder on the upper left corner. Type "Nvivo file lab assignment 4"
- 3. Drop your NVIVO file into this folder.

Paste the Nvivo File link
