**A FINANCE BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO ALLOCATE STUDENT
GOVERNMENT FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUPPORTING THE RETURN OF
STUDENTS ON CAMPUS FOR SPRING 2021 SEMESTER**

Second Reading:

WHEREAS, the University announced on September 23, 2020 the plans for the Spring 2021 semester for a mix of online, hybrid, and in-person classes¹; and,

WHEREAS, the University announced on October 22, 2020 that the Spring 2021 Term would begin on January 19th, 2021²; and,

WHEREAS, the Protect the Pack Community Standards for COVID-19 requires students to wear a face covering while in “University buildings, classrooms and anywhere else on campus, indoors or outdoors, when they cannot maintain appropriate physical distancing (6 feet) from another person”³; and,

WHEREAS, to best support and keep students safe, Student Government should support the Student Body by providing materials to support public health;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED, that the North Carolina State University Student Senate allocates \$5000 from Line Item 101 - Finance Committee Disbursements to purchase Student Government branded masks and hand sanitizer for the return of students on campus; and be it further

ENACTED, this bill shall become effective upon its enrollment.
