- Coding- Students will do basic coding with coding sites like Code.org and Khanacademy.com

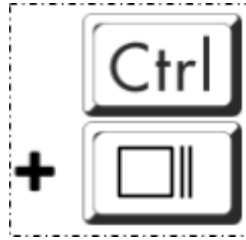
