



What is Jeopardy Labs?

Jeopardy Labs is a **website where users can create and customize their own jeopardy game templates for free**. Instructors can use this tool to create jeopardy-style games for reviewing material with students during classes, which may be helpful before a test.

Why use Jeopardy Labs?

Jeopardy Labs **allows the teacher to view the student's knowledge about a topic**. The students could answer the questions through the whole class, small groups, pairs, or individually. This tool allows the teacher to view which areas the students are secure in and which areas they are struggling with.
