Mike gave an update on Reflections on Swanton Art Show. Swanton Historical Society agreed to split costs and marketing materials are in process. The historical society has pictures to view for references 1800-1950's. Discussion followed in how to make the photos available electronically.

Town Plan Update – Michelle stated the town plan edit is moving forward, Committee of Cyl, David, Janet, and Michelle formed to create SAC proposal of edits for May 2022

SPAN – Cyl explained that SPAN is also discussing submitting town plan proposed edits for more public art. She asked everyone present to think about joining SPAN on any level and especially the mural program that is in formation as the next project for SPAN. Continuing tailgate parties for spring and fall are planned with a possible winter gathering at David's. More to come.

Cyl spoke of the information collected at SAC's annual meeting in December. SAC received top marks on classes, public spaces and art or art focused events

Jay asked for support of her project Gathering of The Realms. It will be a two-day renaissance faire hopefully held at the recreation fields. Many discussions in process to make it happen.

Judy spoke of the Artist Showcase and sales from December that were held in the library. Price point sales information was gathered as well as types of items that were successful. She recommends that it does not get repeated though as it was not as popular as was hoped. Crafts did not sell well at all, and arts went best with price points from 15\$ to \$90. Khristian, Bona and Jay will meet to form a committee to discuss jewelry displays as permanent fixtures in the library for future jewelry showing.

Judy has the Art Nook up and running with VanJoe's opening going very well. She ran through the names in order with the explanation that if any artist is not ready for their time slot, they will be allowed to push back a month and the next artist will go ahead of them. Expectations are 2 month shows with nine artists currently signed up.

Judy discussed the Emerging Artist and Youth Art Show. Requests for participants has gone out to the schools. Stay tuned for updates.

Jay requested permission to accept the Milton Artist's Guild invite to join in the second annual raffle. All in favor of continuing with the collaboration. Jay to report back next meeting of progress.

Jay brought up grants. SAC has been invited to submit a full proposal for Animating Infrastructure. She is in discussions with SEP, SAC, the Rec, Fast Food Sunday and the Farmer's market coordinators to fill in the needed information. She also expressed the fit for SAV and the SPARK grant. No apparent interest for this round.
