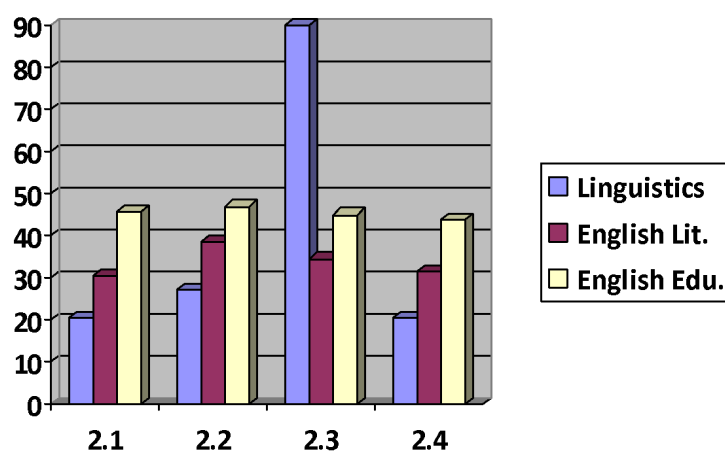


Figure 1. Number of subtheme published
