
Chronicle Comics: Axel "Nova" Moreno

Personality Profile:

Losing Control: Axel's greatest fear is that his unstable energy will hurt the people he cares about or destroy everything around him.

Backstory

Axel Nova grew up in the bustling city of Los Angeles, where his parents worked on cutting-edge clean energy technology. Fascinated by their research, Axel often accompanied his parents into their lab to watch their various experiments. One night, during an experiment with an advanced energy core called the **Aether Dynamo**, the device malfunctioned, unleashing a chaotic surge of raw, unstable energy. Axel was caught in the blast, his body absorbing the Aether Dynamo's energy, which rewrote his physiology.

The Aether Dynamo turned Axel into a living energy generator, his body pulsing with power he couldn't control. Each time he released even a fraction of it, the results were catastrophic. The energy also acted as a beacon, attracting unwanted attention.

Klyte's Arrival:

A Fragile Partnership:

Klyte is more than just a tool; it is an advanced Al with its own personality, combining cold logic with a wry, observant demeanor. It often criticizes Axel's impulsiveness while offering sarcastic quips about human behavior. Despite their differences, the two realize they must work together—Axel to avoid tearing himself apart with his power, and Klyte to protect Earth from the energy anomalies that Axel's condition creates.

Their symbiosis allows Axel to transform into **Nova**, a fusion of human ingenuity and alien technology, capable of channeling the volatile energy into powerful armor modes. Klyte also acts as Axel's guide, using its vast knowledge of the universe to prepare him for the threats the Dynamo energy has drawn to Earth.

Core Conflict:

Axel's relationship with Klyte is a constant tug-of-war. Klyte believes Axel's power should be honed for larger, galactic-scale threats, but Axel is determined to focus on protecting his friends, family, and home. Meanwhile, members of the Celarion Order, have taken notice of its bond with Axel—and they want both of them back.

As Axel learns to master his powers and Klyte begins to understand humanity, the two form an unbreakable partnership. Together, they must face not only external enemies but also the internal challenge of balancing their vastly different perspectives on duty, power, and freedom.

Abilities and Skills

<u>POWERS</u>

Alien Symbiosis:

 Axel and Klyte are bonded on a molecular level, creating a fusion of human adaptability and alien technology. Axel generates an endless supply of volatile Dynamo energy, while Klyte channels and stabilizes it, enabling them to manifest specialized armor modes. Each mode is designed for specific combat or environmental needs, drawing directly from Axel's energy reserves, making their success reliant on teamwork and balance. The armor evolves over time as Axel and Klyte's bond deepens, unlocking new abilities and greater control.

Armour Modes:

- Blaster Mode: Axel and Klyte's ninth transformation. One of Axel's most powerful
 modes, Rocket Mode is equipped with four extremely potent blasters that allow him
 to fly, and can be repositioned to be used as cannons. His Armor is extremely
 resistant as well, being capable of withstanding the vacuum of space. It requires
 large amounts of D.Y.N.A.M.O energy in order to function.
- Titan Mode: Axel and Klyte's eighth transformation. Axel becomes a giant and has a
 pair of floating blades on his back that can work as swords. These potent weapons
 vibrate through molecules, and can theoretically cut through anything, as well as
 unleash powerful energy blasts.

- Bulwark Mode: Axel's seventh transformation. He is protected by a large and sturdy armor. By charging D.Y.N.A.M.O energy, Axel can launch himself at enemies like a cannonball, dealing large amounts of damage. In the process, he is virtually invulnerable. In turn, Turbo Cannon Mode requires vast amounts of D.Y.N.A.M.O energy in order to function.
- Flight Mode: Axel and Klyte's sixth transformation. As the name suggests, it gives Axel
 the power of flight, allowing him to travel through the air at high speed. Also
 possessing a heat shield to protect the user from re-entry. It is able to reach beyond
 the stratosphere.
- Speed Mode: Axel and Klyte's fifth transformation. Its aerodynamic design allows Axel to run at supersonic speeds. It also enhances his reflexes. However, the suit requires large amounts of D.Y.N.A.M.O energy in order to function.
- Scuba Mode: Axel and Klyte's fourth transformation. Its armor allows Axel to adapt to
 underwater environments, featuring a sleek hydrodynamic design to swim faster in
 the water. Besides offering enhanced strength, speed and durability underwater,
 Dynamo Scuba Mode's armor is incredibly resistant, being capable of withstanding
 ocean pressure and extremely cold temperatures.
- Camouflage Mode: Axel's third transformation. It is used to hide his secret identity
 and to blend with other humans. It is able to recreate any fabric, material or texture
 and offers limited strength, speed and agility. Axel's usual attire consists of a indigo
 jumper with a black Klyte logon on the chest area, black jeans, sneakers and a watch
 on his left wrist.
- Strength Mode: Also referred to as Defense Protocol A109, Strength Mode is Axel and Klyte's second transformation. Approximately three times stronger than Base Mode,
 Dynamo Strength Mode is used to achieve maximum strength in combat. While it increases Axel's power and defence, it decreases his speed and agility. The more

- energy Axel generates, the stronger he gets. He can also enlarge the armor by generating more D.Y.N.A.M.O energy.
- Base Mode: Also referred to as "Dynamo Armour", Base Mode is Axel and Klyte's very
 first transformation. It offers enhanced strength, reflexes and agility and amplifies
 the user's fighting capabilities and senses. It can never be taken off, although Klyte
 can change its look to make it seem like ordinary attire via camouflage mode.

Telepathic Bond:

Axel and Klyte share a powerful telepathic connection, allowing them to communicate
instantly and seamlessly. This bond enables Klyte to provide real-time guidance,
warnings, and tactical advice, while Axel can focus on making decisions without the
need for words. The telepathy also helps them synchronize during battle, ensuring
perfect coordination between Axel's actions and Klyte's strategic input.

Manifestation:

- Although Axel and Klyte remain bonded at all times, Klyte has the ability to manifest
 a protective, semi-physical form outside of Axel's body. This manifestation allows
 Klyte to interact with the environment, observe the surroundings, and communicate
 more directly with others, without being restricted to the telepathic link.
- Klyte's Appearance: Klyte appears as a smooth, floating spherical object, roughly the
 size of a human head. His surface is sleek and metallic, with a soft, pearlescent sheen
 that shifts in color depending on the light, ranging from cool blues and purples to
 warm golds and oranges. At his core, he features a glowing, crystalline eye,
 constantly shifting and pulsing with light, signifying the Al consciousness inside. The

eye has an almost holographic, iridescent quality, flickering occasionally to convey emotion or communication. Around his circumference, faint geometric patterns or symbols occasionally appear and fade. He floats effortlessly, always hovering just slightly above the ground or within reach of Axle, emitting a faint hum of energy as he analyzes, processes, and interacts with the world around it.

Learned Skills

Tactical Thinking:

 Through experience, Axel has learned how to think on his feet and lead others in high-stress situations. He's developed the ability to make quick decisions in combat, often deferring to Klynt when stakes are high.

Multilingual Understanding:

 Axel has the ability to fluently speak a number of languages due to his bond with Klynt. Some of these include; Spanish, French, Mandarin and some alien dialects. This skill helps him communicate and understand key information in diverse environments.

Weaknesses

Dependency on Klyte for Energy Control:

Axel's unstable Dynamo energy can be overwhelming to his body if left unchecked.
 Without Klyte's constant assistance in stabilizing and absorbing the energy, Axel risks experiencing violent energy surges that would kill him and cause uncontrollable explosions. If separated from Klyte for any reason (thought that is almost impossible unless Klyte willingly does so) then the effects would come quickly.

Energy Emissions Attract Alien Attention:

The Dynamo energy Axel generates is constantly emitted, creating a unique and
detectable signature in space. This energy signature acts as a beacon, unintentionally
drawing the attention of hostile alien forces or curious entities from other worlds,
who he battles frequently.
