The Special Needs Track Program is designed to provide special needs athletes, *including those in wheelchairs*, from ages **8 and above** with an opportunity to participate in instruction and activity related to Special Olympic events.

Participation involves:

- ★ **Practices** that are designed to get athletes moving, try out the events, socialize with each other and have fun
- ★ **A track meet:** On May 11th, athletes will have the opportunity to compete against other special needs peers within their age and ability group at the Area 6 Special Olympics Track meet at Long Branch High School. **(Only those ages 8 and older can participate at the meet on May 11th at Long Branch H.S.)**
