  - Lots of activities for grades 7&8s the last week before holidays – movie afternoon, dance, student/staff games.
  - Grades 7/8 students who are in need of Chromebooks can sign out a device for the year.
  - Grades 7/8 Play – December 11<sup>th</sup>, evening and daytime performances.
  - New lockers – it took 3 years to get these but we are happy they are installed. Every student has a locker.
  - Curtain installation – the doors were not able to be repaired and we have replaced them with curtains so the gyms can be separated.
