## College of Information Technology Advisory Board Meeting Minutes February 23, 2022

The meeting was called to order by Dr. Na Li at 6:00 p.m. EST.

A motion to approve the Baker College Mission and CoIT Mission was made, seconded, and unanimously approved.

The minutes from the October 14, 2021 meeting were approved.

Dr. Na Li provided a welcome and thanked advisory board members for their time and talents.


Dr. Na Li provided a College of Information Technology update to the advisory board, including the program assessment data trends, CoIT strategic goals, progress on the 21-22 continuous improvement plan, and the submission of the CAE-CD annual report.

Ed Bissett reported on the program change for 22-23, course delivery modality changes for 22-23, and the Course Review and Improvement Process (CRIP) work that CoIT has completed and is conducting.

## Other points discussed:

- For program assessment data analysis and report
  - To include sample sizes when reporting assessment data in next meeting
  - What classes are we looking at? To focus less on intro classes and more on higher level courses.
- Student population by age
- Minimum GPA/ACT/SAT scores for incoming students
- Are students meeting minimum expectations in prereqs (writing, tech, etc)?
- Student communication skills: The following figure shows student ratings how well Baker College
  prepared them for written and oral communication skills in the last three academic years,
  reflected in the End of Program Survey. Note: The percentages of MSIS student whose ratings
  were equal to or higher than "average" on written and oral communication skills were both
  100% in each year.
