RE

Reflection - due Wednesday

Reading

Spelling

- If you're in the Vocab Extension group, choose 5 new words to learn. Write them in your spelling book with the definition and a sentence for each one. You will be tested on their spelling and meanings.

 - Use the words on the sheet provided e.g: *algorithm*, *code*, *debug*... in your explanation and show that you know what they mean.
 - Include an explanation of your design and say how you decided what would go on it.
 - Make the video of your team explaining your Makey Makey and show it actually working.
 - Edit your video so that it flows smoothly and has a range of shots, e.g. close up, wide-angle.
 - The video needs to be uploaded onto your blog, so think about the length.
