When, where and who

The 'Kids Safe Online' Calendar Contest is free to enter, and open to all K-12 students across the state. One winner per grade will be selected, including the Overall Winner, who will have their artwork featured on the cover of the 2027 calendar.

Dates to Remember:

- **Friday, September 18:** All entries are due.
- **Wednesday, October 7:** Winners will be announced.
- **Thursday, October 8:** Winning entries will go on display at the [Arizona State Fair](#), where they will remain until Sunday, November 1, 2026.
- **Friday, December 11:** A virtual copy of the 2027 calendar, featuring the winning artwork, will be electronically shared.
- **January 2027:** Winning entries will be displayed at multiple galleries throughout the state in partnership with [Young Arts Arizona](#).
