S.4.1. traffic safety in and outside the campus;

Enhanced Campus Security Features / Traffic Rules:

1. Main Gate Management on Regular Days
 - The main gate is the designated entrance and exit point, monitored and managed by on-duty security personnel.
 - Guards verify identification and conduct routine checks on all individuals entering and exiting the premises to ensure a secure and controlled environment.
2. Strict Entry Requirements
 - Vehicle Access: A valid vehicle gate pass is mandatory for all vehicles entering the campus. Staff and students must display this pass for entry.
 - ID Verification: All staff and students are required to carry and present a valid school-issued identification card at the entrance. This measure helps confirm identities and control unauthorized access.
3. Visitor Registration and Access Control
 - All visitors, including guests, tourists, and external personnel, must present a government-issued ID and register in a general logbook at the security post. IDs are kept with security until departure, and a visitor pass is issued for the duration of their stay.
 - Guards monitor visitor movement within the campus to ensure adherence to access restrictions.
4. One-Way Traffic for Large Events
 - During major events, the campus enforces a strict one-way traffic flow:
 - a. Entrance Only: The main gate is reserved exclusively for entrance, minimizing traffic congestion and improving crowd control.
 - b. Exit Only: Two designated sub-gates are used as exits, ensuring an organized flow and reducing exit bottlenecks. All gates are supervised by on-duty guards.
 - This controlled setup enhances the safety and efficiency of campus entry and exit during large-scale gatherings.
5. Additional Traffic and Safety Support for Events
 - Uniformed personnel, such as local traffic enforcement or school security volunteers, are requested to assist with crowd management, traffic flow, and general safety during events with high attendance. Their presence improves overall coordination and helps manage unexpected issues.
6. Advanced Surveillance and Monitoring System
 - Security cameras are strategically installed throughout the campus, covering key areas like entrances, exits, parking lots, main walkways, and common gathering points.
 - Live monitoring from a centralized security room allows guards to detect suspicious activities in real-time and respond quickly to incidents.
