Subject: Approval of 2023-2024 WPCC budget

What is your question or proposal to the board?

I would entertain a motion to adopt a 2023-2024 budget as drafted in the document below.

Why are you proposing this board discussion or action?

Our deadline for applying for city funding for 2023 and 2024 is Monday, Oct. 31. The application process requires us to submit a budget for the next two years.

What budget or resource considerations are associated with this discussion?

We must approve this in order to qualify for city funding for the next two years. We are projected to receive \$11,198 from the city in each of the next two years, with \$1,198 of that reserved for equitable engagement activities.

What is your question or proposal to the board?

I move that the WPCC supports the city buying tax forfeit property at 3300 Buchanan ST NE , MINNEAPOLIS, MN 55418.

Why are you proposing this board discussion or action?

If the city buys the property, it is guaranteed to be sold as affordable housing or to be sold is a primary residence to someone below the area median income.

What budget or resource considerations are associated with this discussion?

No cost, simple motion and email to Bob Cooper.

Is there any additional information that might help board members prepare for this discussion/vote? If so, please share or describe below.

Below are the three common recommendations made (though we could certainly make a different recommendation):

- Classifying property as conservation, meaning that it would be retained for a public park or natural resource and cannot be sold to private parties
- Requesting acquisition by the City of Minneapolis, in order to support neighborhood and City plans. If you are recommending that we acquire a property, it is helpful to provide a one sentence description about how it would support neighborhood and/or City plans.
- Recommending sale by Hennepin County through its auction process
