

Hanover School District 28 Accessibility Compliance Plan

Hanover School District 28 is committed to ensuring that our website and student software is accessible to all individuals, including those with disabilities. We strive to maintain digital compliance under HB21-1110 and Colorado's Student Data Transparency and Security Act. We plan to follow the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.1, developed by the World Wide Web Consortium (W3C).

This plan will feature three main parts: Spanish translations, student data privacy protection, and accessibility.

Website Compliance Plan:

- Hanover School District 28 to work with Wordpress website platform's Accessibility Checker feature to provide accessibility recommendations to the website.
- Hanover School District 28 to undergo regular Accessibility assessments/checks to rate the website's accessibility features.
- Hanover School District 28 to work on changing files, forms, and documents on the website so that there are Spanish translations available for each item (if the option is available) and so that PDFs are not static and are instead linked to Google Drive/Docs for Google's accessibility options.
- Hanover School District 28 to update plan progress on this document quarterly.
- Hanover School District 28 may purchase a subscription to a website accessibility menu or consider a different platform with better accessibility features once our contract with BlueHost ends.

Software Compliance Plan:

- Hanover School District 28 employees to submit a Software Request form for IT approval.
- Hanover School District 28 to finish out contracts with non-compliant organizations before seeking software or applications with organizations that have better accessibility features.
- Software to meet data privacy (achieved through a signed Data Protection Addendum with the district) and accessibility requirements.
- On-demand service provider tools (apps and extensions through Google Workspace) to be exempt from DPA agreements.

Applicable Tools/Steps for Key Stakeholders:

1. Hanover School District 28 employees to move any scanned PDFs to Word, Google Docs or other Google applications because of the available [accessibility features](#).

2. Hanover School District 28 employees to start to translate documents by using the [translation tool](#) in Google Docs, Claude or [DeepL](#) when they are able to. Another option is the image/document section of [Google Translate](#).
3. Hanover School District 28 employees to use [PAC 2021](#) the PDF Accessibility Checker and [translation](#) tools for all created Canva documents and resources.
4. Hanover School District 28 employees to add video accessibility (enabling captions) to [Google Classroom](#) or [Zoom](#). For recorded videos without captions, employees will either upload unlisted videos to [YouTube](#) or use [CapCut](#) for automated captions and translated captions.
5. Hanover School District 28 to request event holders to provide a copy of posters in Spanish for social media content sharing.

Training

We provide accessibility training and skill-building opportunities to all Hanover School District 28 employees through tutorials.

Additionally, we support our staff through an accessibility area with a variety of resources on site, through Professional Development, and a team dedicated to accessibility.

Staff Training:

1. Hanover School District 28 to provide information at the start-of-the-year to all staff. Staff are responsible for understanding the material.
2. IT staff to provide 1-on-1 with key stakeholders if requested.

Remediation:

1. Changes to be requested via the [Website Update form](#).
2. Complaints to be submitted to the Hanover School District 28 using the currently Board of Education approved Grievance Policy & Procedures form.

Accessibility Maturity
