



Sunflower Seed Headband Crochet Pattern

I was scrolling through Pinterest looking for a crochet stitch to use that had nice texture and I found the Seed Stitch. I recently designed a Sunflower Applique and had a great idea, combine the Seed Stitch with the Sunflower Applique and call it Sunflower Seed Headband! Inside this crochet pattern you will find 3 crochet patterns, a Headband, a Sunflower and a Leaf Applique. The Leaf Applique was designed by 13 year old Miss Smith, this was her very first crochet design with step-by-step Picture Tutorials! 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I used Red Heart Super Saver Worsted Weight Yarn in Chocolate and Gold. 100% Acrylic Yarn (198g / 7oz, 333m / 364yd)

Headband

Materials:

US H or 5 mm Crochet Hook
50-75 yds of Worsted/Aran Weight Yarn
Scissors
Tapestry Needle
1" Button (Optional)

Abbreviations/Stitches Used:

ch = chain
sc = single crochet
dc = double crochet
st = stitch
sp = space
RS = Right Side
WS = Wrong Side

Notes:

[Sunflower Applique](#) is below the Headband Crochet Pattern.

Sizes are 2-4 years, 5-10 years, Teen, and Adult consecutively.

ch 3 counts as a dc

alt ch 2 counts as a dc

Below the Sunflower Applique pattern there is an Optional pattern for [Leaves](#)

Special Stitches:

Alternate chain 2 – takes the place of a chain 3, creating a cleaner edge with no gaps. It also counts as a dc.

Seed Stitch – consists of alternating sc and dc. In the 2nd row you will switch and add a dc in a sc and a sc in a dc.

Gauge:

US H or 5mm Crochet Hook
12 st x 12 rows = 4"

If you prefer to do a Gauge Swatch, use the pattern instructions below for size Teen/Adult for 12 row.

[Sunflower Applique](#)

Materials:

US H or 5 mm Crochet Hook
MC - 15 yds of Worsted/Aran Weight Yarn
Scissors
Tapestry Needle

rep = repeat

alt ch 2 = alternate chain 2

MC = Main Color (brown)

CC = Contrasting Color (yellow)

Headband Crochet Pattern:



Using MC (brown)

Sizes 2-4 years

R1: fsc 9 turn (9 sc)

Optional: ch 10 sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc across. turn (9 sc)

R2 (RS): ch 1, sc in same sp. *dc in next st, sc in next st. rep from * until last st, sc in last st. turn (9 st)

R3(WS): alt ch 2 or ch 3, sc in the next st, *dc in the next st, sc in next st. rep from * until last st, dc in last st. turn (9 st)

R4-R40: Repeat R2-R3 or until you reach your desired head circumference

After R40 sl st to join **OR** see the Button Option below

5-10 years

R1: fsc 9 turn (9 sc)

Optional: ch 10 sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc across. turn (9 sc)

R2 (RS): ch 1, sc in same sp. *dc in next st, sc in next st. rep from * until last st, sc in last st. turn (9 st)

R3(WS): alt ch 2 or ch 3, sc in the next st, *dc in the next st, sc in next st. rep from * until last st, dc in last st. turn (9 st)

R4-R45: Repeat R2-R3 or until you reach your desired head circumference

After R45 sl st to join **OR** see the Button Option below.

Teen

R1: fsc 12 turn (12 sc)

Optional: ch 13, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc across. turn (12 sc)

R2 (RS): ch 1, sc in same sp. *dc in next st, sc in next st. rep from * until last st, sc in last st. turn (12 st)

R3(WS): alt ch 2 or ch 3, *sc in the next st, dc in the next st. rep from * until last st, sc in last st. turn (12 st)

R4-R50: Repeat R2 or until you reach your desired head circumference

After R50 sl st to join **OR** see the Button Option below

Adult

R1: fsc 12 turn (12 sc)

Optional: ch 13, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc across. turn (12 sc)

R2 (RS): ch 1, sc in same sp. *dc in next st, sc in next st. rep from * until last st, dc in last st. turn (12 st)

R3(WS): alt ch 2 or ch 3, *sc in the next st, dc in the next st. rep from * until last st, sc in last st. turn (12 st)

R4-R55: Repeat R2 or until you reach your desired head circumference

After R55 sl st to join **OR** see the Button Option below

Button Option

R1: ch 1, sc in same sp, sc in the next (2, 2, 3, 3 st) ch 3, sk next (3, 3, 4, 4 st), sc in remaining st. turn (6, 6, 8, 8 sc)

R2: ch 1, sc in same sp, sc in next (2, 2, 3, 3 st) 3 sc in ch-3 sp, sc in remaining st. (9, 9, 12, 12 st)

Fasten off and weave in ends.

Line up button wherever you prefer on the opposite end of the RS of and Sew in place.



Sunflower Applique Crochet Pattern:

Finished Flower Size:

5" x 5"

Notes:

I used 2 colors for my flower, chocolate and gold.

The flower is worked in the round.

The flower petals are worked in the chain spaces.

If you would like to make a smaller sunflower, you can use #3 ply Lightweight or DK Weight Yarn.

For the smaller flower it is recommended to use a US F or 3.75 mm Crochet Hook.

Using CC

R1: Make a magic circle, ch 1, 20 sc in the magic circle, pull magic circle closed and sl st in 1st sc to join. (20 sc)



Magic Circle

20 sc

Pull Magic Circle Closed

R2: ch1, sc in same st, *ch 3, sk next st, sc in next st. rep from * around. sl st into 1st sc to join. (10 ch-3 sp)

Fasten off and weave in ends.



R2

Change to MC

R3: *(sc, 2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc, sc) all in the ch-3 sp. rep from * around. sl st in 1st st to join. (10 petals)



R3

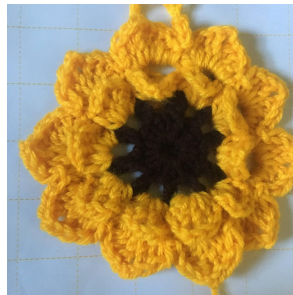
Second layer of flower:

R4: working behind the petals from the previous round *ch 5, sl st in sc of next petal. rep from * around until last petal. ch 5. sl st in 1st ch-5 sp to join. (10 ch-5 sp)



R4

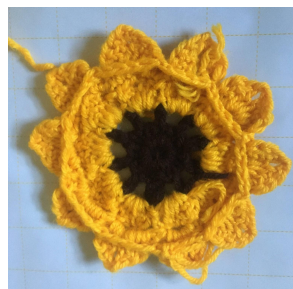
R5: ch 1 *(sc, 3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc, sc) all in the same sp. rep from * around. sl st in 1st st to join. (10 Petals)



R5

3rd layer of flower:

R6: working behind the petals from the previous round *ch 6, sl st in sc of next petal. rep from * until last petal. ch 6. sl st in 1st ch-6 sp. (10 ch-6 sp)



R6

R7: ch 1 *(sc, 4 dc, ch 2, 4 dc, sc) all in the same sp. rep from * around. sl st in 1st st to join.
(10 Petals)



R7

Fasten off and weave in ends.

Using a long tail of your flower center color of yarn, sew the Sunflower Applique to your desired placement.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

Leaf Appliqué



Leaf Crochet Pattern

R1: magic circle. (6 dc, ch 3 ,6 dc, ch 3) all in magic circle. sl st in 1st dc to join.



6 dc, ch 3



6 dc, ch 3, sl st to 1st dc to join.

R2: ch 2, dc in same st *2 dc in next st, dc in next st. rep from * until last ch-3sp. (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) all in last ch-3 sp. sl st in 1st st to join.



ch 2, dc in same st *2 dc in next st, dc in next st. rep from * until ch-3 sp



(2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) all in ch-3 sp



*dc in next st, 2 dc in next st. rep from * until ch-3 sp



(2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) all in ch-3 sp. sl st in 1st st to join.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

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That's it! You have finished crocheting your Sunflower Seed Headband! There are so many sizes you can make with this Headband! You can customize the sizes above using a #3 ply DK lightweight yarn.

There are also SO many ways you can use the Sunflower and Leaf Appliques! You can add them to handbags, scarves, hats, and so much more!
