

To ensure this community is as valuable to everyone as possible, here are some simple rules that I ask everyone to follow. Failure to follow these rules may result in a temporary or permanent ban from the community.

1. Staying on-topic

This is a place for product people to gather and nerd out about all things product, it's not an open platform for any old topic. For this reason I ask that you keep any threads on topic, and that you ensure your posts fit in one of our categories for posts!

Note: If you want to discuss politics, societal issues, or any sort of causes or movements - this is not the place to do it.

2. Don't be an asshole.

I get it, you've got strong opinions - but if you like being overly negative, sarcastic, or rude to others then this isn't the community for you! I ask that you keep it light, be helpful and try to keep it positive!

There's nothing wrong with a little joking around with each other, but outright trolling and aggressive debate won't be tolerated.

3. No Self Promo, Selling, Links, Direct Messages...

I want this community to be a place where people come to learn from one another, meet interesting folks with similar interests, and accelerate their career growth. For this reason, I'll ask that you avoid blatant self promotion.

This means posts that are fishing for clients, selling stuff, promoting your business, asking people to DM (or sending DMs with pitches for work) will likely be removed.
