This should be not a long comment, and its purpose is to open the floor for discussions.
- If you plan **a brainstorm or an artistic workshop**, please have some assignments ready and let us know if you need some additional material for that.
- If you did not plan anything and you see your name in the program, tell us about your current research/study -- when we organize this symposium we suggest that everyone is **actively participating** (unlike a boring conference).
