

Pearson: How Students Connect their Google Classroom to Pearson Envision

Step 1. Click the Pearson assignment in Google Classroom.

Step 2. Click the account for the student

Step 3. Click 'Allow'

Step 4. Pick a language, icon, background image, and click 'Let's Go!' at the bottom.

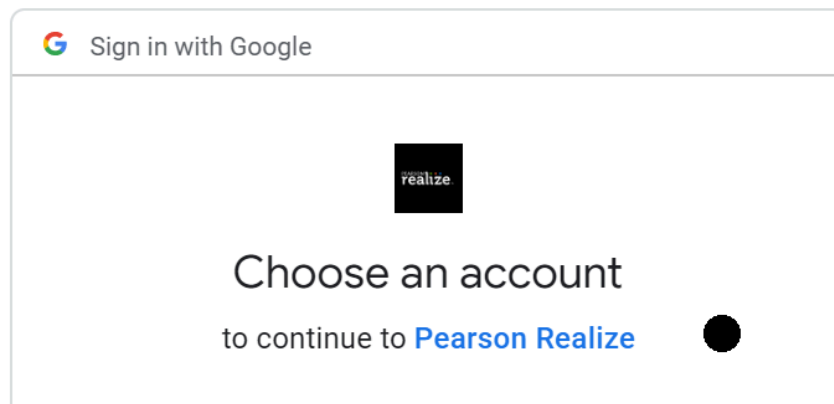
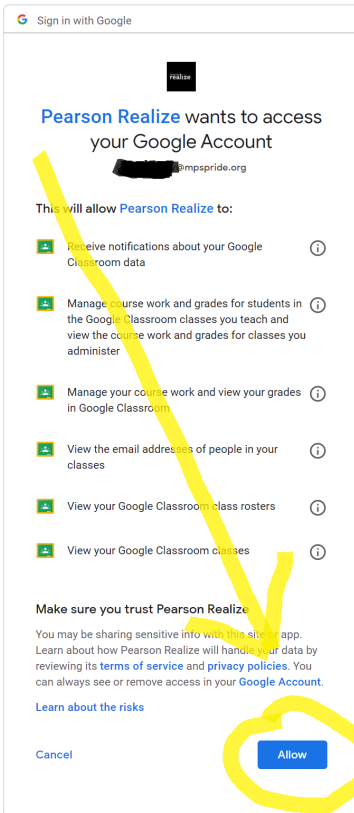

Troubleshooting Tips

Problem 1:

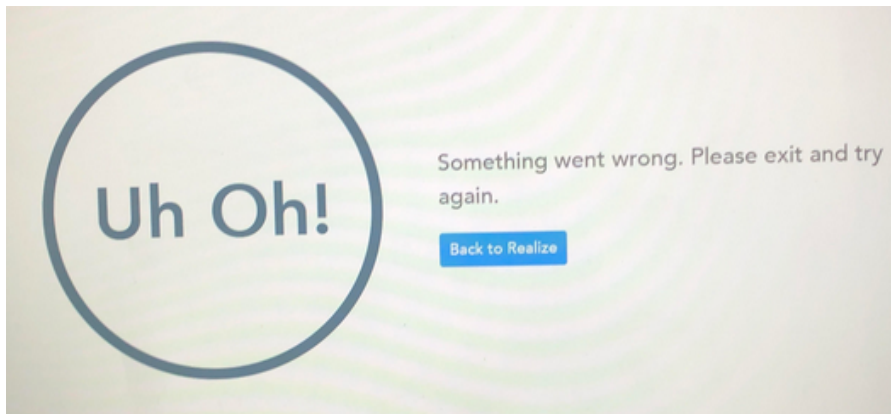

Solution: Let your teacher know about the error. They may need to reassign it a second time. This can happen if the assignment was given before the student connected their Google and Pearson accounts.

Problem 2:



Solution: This can happen if your wireless connection is slow or weak. It can also happen if the Pearson network is overloaded. We suggest restarting the device and trying again. You can also attempt to do this at a different time of day when the servers may not be so busy.

Problem 3:

Trying to do an assignment but the screen doesn't load, or only partially loads.

Solution: This can happen if your wireless connection is slow or weak. It can also happen if the Pearson network is overloaded, or if you walked away from the device and it timed out. We suggest restarting the device and trying again. You can also attempt to do this at a different time of day when the servers may not be so busy.

Problem 4:

When working on an assignment, you are unable to save your work, or the save button is grayed out.

Solution: This can happen if you have too many Pearson tabs open, or have the same assignment opened in more than one tab or window. This can also happen if you were in the middle of a lesson, and left the device inactive for an extended period of time. We suggest closing all tabs/windows except for the current lesson, and Google Classroom. If that doesn't help, you may need to restart your device or browser.

Setting up the Early Learning Theme in Pearson

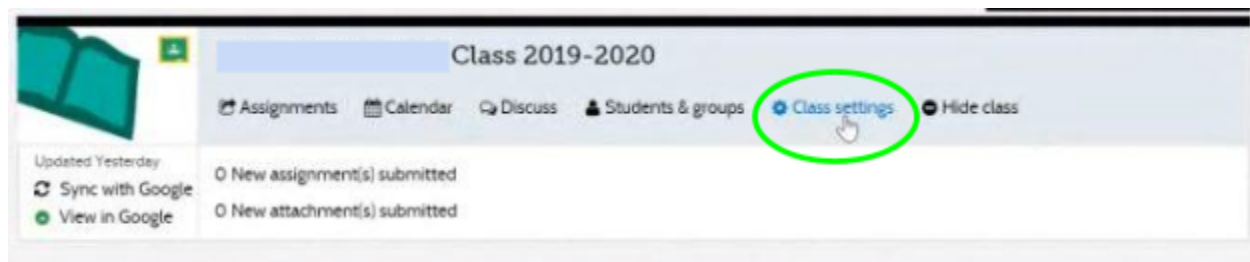
Pearson has a setting called “Early Learning Theme” in enVision 2.0 which allows the setup to be easier and more user friendly for our K-2 friends. This can be done for your full class, or for just individual students in your class.

Here are step by step directions on how to set this for your whole class.

Log into your home screen and select “Classes”




From here, go into Class Settings



Once in Class Settings, scroll down to the bottom of the page. There is a selection for Early Learning Theme. Click it, and “Save.”



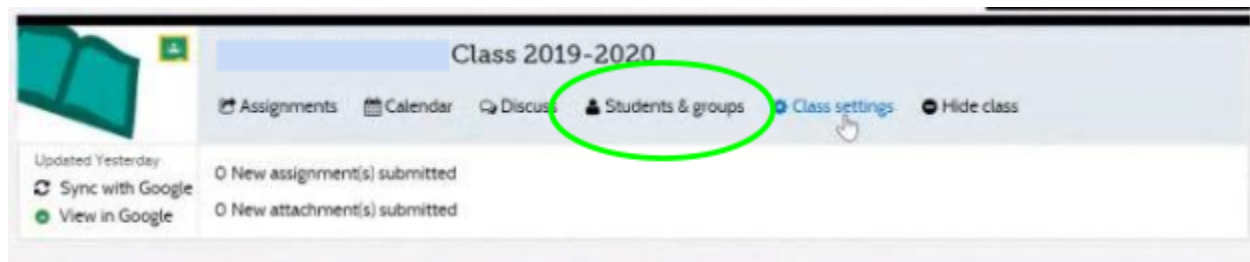

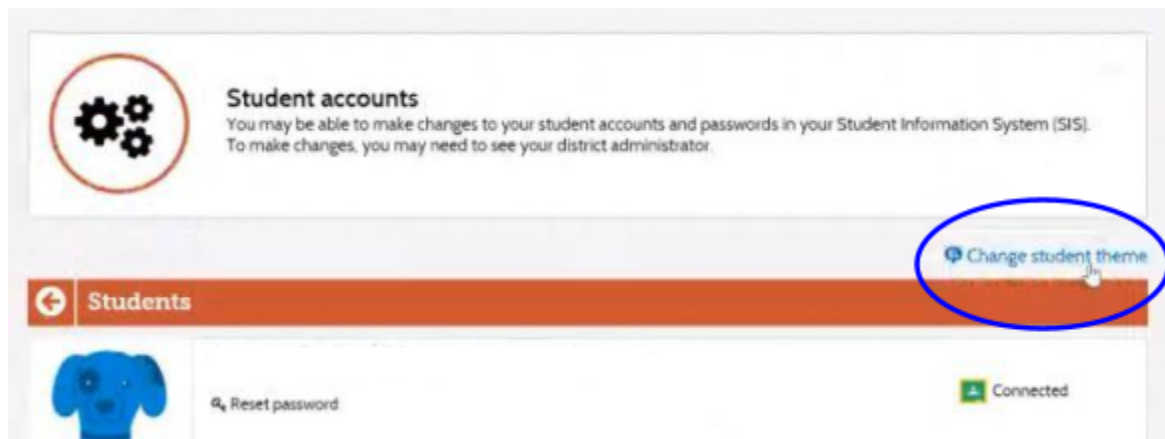
Log into your home screen and select “Classes”
