NESCO- land use committee meeting 4/4/24-10th and Rural Marathon Station is only topic on agenda, gas station agreed not to sell rolling papers, have pushed for being able to sell them now, they have started a conversation with ownership there to see if they would be willing to sign up for IMPD Blink business program, KIB adopt a block, and other community initiatives to keep gas station from being nuisance/crime haven.

Conflict resolution- if any neighbors are interested in becoming conflict mediator- having a mock trial on Saturday, April 20 from 1-3pm at 1002 E Washington Street

NESCO fundraiser at Ash and Elm- April 16th 4pm-9pm 25% of spend goes to NESCO if you mention to your server/bartender.

NEAR- small neighborhood group trying to do good in the neighborhood, developing/redoin houses Only sell to low to moderate income households. Huge investment in old RCA site- Sherman Park, in redevelopment plan. Eventual plan to connect 10th and rural to pleasant run trail- looking to create a TIFF district just east of 10th and Rural to help infrastructure for local businesses and residences in that area. Near eastside community bike ride beginning at CenterPoint-starts Wednesday, April 10 through October/weather permitting.

Sherman and 9th- Recycleforce would like to open their recycling center there

IMPD- Steve Talley. Next task force meeting Wednesday, April 10- new leader Michael Leepper will be there.

Crimestoppers: can't take victim statements, tips you give to them are not used in court as evidence, they are a non-profit. Just a completely anonymous way to submit suspicious activity. If your tip results in a felony arrest you could win up to \$1000.

Springdale Business

Temple Oak- no damage or major affect to tree with construction happening at Brookside near Temple and Rural. Might need tree funds to treat lace mites that come in the spring/summer

INRC grant- received permits but have not received funding yet, hoping to have at least one sign up for Spring Fling

Public Art for Neighborhood Grant- seek signs for Temple Oak and welcome signs for the neighborhood community garden, benches for Chinquapin Oak Park (INRC won't cover additional signage after this past grant we got) up to \$15,000 per grant
