- Keating has a repository of other documents related to the life of DD Palmer <u>HERE</u>, where you can find <u>a letter from D.D. Palmer to P.W. Johnson</u>, where DD claims that chiropractic must hoist a religious flag to survive the regulating authorities.
 - "we will have to build a boat similar to Christian Science and hoist a religious flag."
 - "Exemption clauses instead of chiro laws by all means, and LET THAT EXEMPTION BE THE RIGHT TO PRACTICE OUR RELIGION."
 - But we must have a religious head, one who is the founder, as did Christ,
 Mohamed, Jo. Smith, Mrs. Eddy, Martin Luther and other who have founded religions."
 - "I am THE ONLY ONE IN CHIROPRACTIC WHO CAN DO SO"
 - "I have received chiropractic from the other world,"
 - "No other one has lad claim to that, NOT EVEN B.J."
- DD Palmer reportedly received an idea from his dead cult leader, Jim Atkinson
 - Claim made <u>here</u>, <u>here</u>, <u>here</u>.
- The Kinsinger Report on Chiropractic presentation is used a few times in our video. You can watch part <u>one</u>, <u>two</u>, and <u>three</u>.
- Many claims were made based on DD Palmer's own writings, mostly from his book "The Chiropractor". We purchased paperback, but Quackwatch has a PDF here
 - "A subluxated vertebra, a vertebral bone, is the cause of 95 percent of all diseases." "Luxated bones," he explains, press against nerves.
 - "The other five percent," he said, "is caused by displaced bones, other than those of the vertebral column,
