Part Time Coach/Daily Rate FREERIDE TEAM SNOWBOARD
Reports to Head Coach and Program Director

1) General Duties

- a) Coach and supervise athletes during training periods and competitions as assigned by Head Coach and Program Director.
- b) Design and implement practices which will provide athletes with the opportunity to:
 - i) learn techniques and tactics of snowboarding;
 - ii) improve the athletes physical readiness to snowboard;
 - iii) improve the athletes mental preparedness to ride ; and
 - iv) develop a sense of team spirit and teamwork among the athletes.
- c) Assist athletes in developing and attaining goals.
- d) Travel to competitions with the Silver Run athletes as assigned according to criteria in the Silver Run Policy Manual.
- e) Facilitate and promote regular communication among team members, parents, and other coaches.
- f) Assist Head Coach/Program Director with athlete evaluations in written format and meetings with athletes and parents.
- g) Assist and oversee activities such as team meetings at home and away events and races.
- h) Participate in community fundraising events
- i) Videotape trainings and comps; review with athletes and coaches.
- j) Participate in continuing education for coaching classes and materials (as approved by the board when funding is required).
- k) Attend to other duties as assigned.

2) Responsibilities and Expectations

- a) Coach is to know and meet the Responsibilities and Expectations as detailed in the Silver Run Employee Manual.
- b) Coaches are expected to present themselves in a professional manner at all times.
- c) Coach is to be available to coach team members when needed throughout the season on a part time basis. In general, the coaches are to be available:
 - i) On weekends to coach at practice or go to chosen/assigned competitions;
 - ii) for the Silver Run Christmas Camp;
 - iii) for team events where possible, such as team meetings, organizational and year end events.
- d) Adhere to the skier responsibility code.

3) Competition Travel

- a) Act in a professional and ethical manner as a positive role model for all athletes.
- b) Monitor team conduct to help athletes follow Silver Run Code of Conduct.
- c) Drive in accordance with state laws and to maintain safety.
- d) Submit receipts to Board Treasurer within 24 hours of return using SRSF reimbursement form.
