Five credits are earned for successful completion of each course every 9-week grading period

English - 40 credits (grades 9, 10, 11, 12)

Math - 20 credits

includes successful completion of Algebra I/CCIM1 (or higher) and one additional math class beyond Algebra I/CCIM1 (Geometry/CCIM2 or higher)

Social Science - 30 credits to include:

(grade 10) World Studies – 10 credits or AP European History or AP Human Geography

(grade 11) US History – 10 credits

(grade 12) Government/Economics – 10 credits

Science - 20 credits to include:

Biological Science – 10 credits and Physical Science – 10 credits

Physical Education - 10/20 credits to include:

Physical Education 9 – 10 credits

Physical Education 10 – (OR PE Waiver through Marching Band)

Health and Wellness – 10 credits

Fine Arts or World Language – 10 credits

Additional Credits – 110 credits
