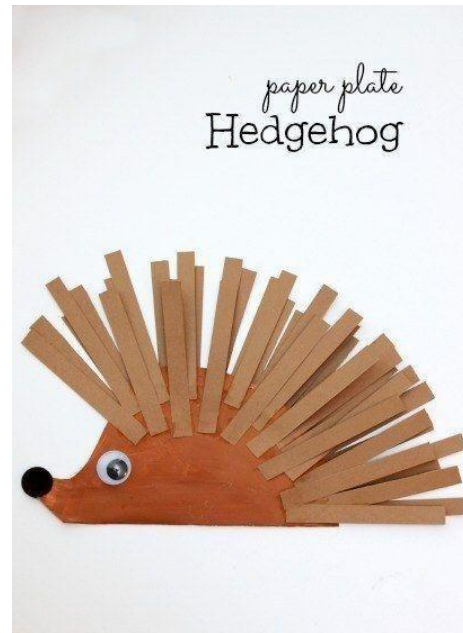


Project – A hedgehog



The body is made of brown cardboard.

The prickles are made of several different materials: cardboard, corrugated cardboard, texture cardboard, felt.

Provide several options of eyes (googly eyes, buttons, beads, etc.) and nose (pompom, cotton ball painted black).

Attach details with double-sided tape (stick it to the edge of the hedgehog's body).

Precut all the necessary parts for the craft in advance: the body (brown cardboard), the prickles (you may use cardboard, corrugated cardboard, felt etc; eyes (googly eyes, buttons, beads, etc.) and nose (pompom, cotton ball painted black).

Give each child precut parts of a hedgehog and a glue stick.

Show kids a picture of a hedgehog.

- *Do you know who it is? It is a hedgehog! Say: This is a hedgehog!*

Help children to adhere all the parts (with glue sticks, wet glue, plasticine, stapler if needed, double-sided sticky tape). Ask kids, discuss the craft.

- *First of all, we will create a hedgehog.*
- *Let me give you some parts of the hedgehog. Here is the body of the hedgehog*
Say: This is the body of the hedgehog.
- *Touch it. What does it feel like? It is rough (about the body of the hedgehog). Say: it is rough.*
- *Does your hedgehog need eyes? Say: Yes, our hedgehog needs eyes. We have many eyes to choose from.*
- *Let's explore and touch them. Here I have googly eyes – can you touch them? What do they feel like? They are smooth . Say: googly eyes are smooth. Here are dough beads eyes – can you touch them? What do they feel like? They are soft. Say: beads eyes are soft. - Which one would you like? Say: I would like/prefer these eyes.*

Now we need to adhere the eyes. How are you going to attach them? Do you need a glue stick or plasticine? Look, I am attaching it with plasticine. You see, I am sticking it with plasticine (repeat it, but with a synonym). Say: I shall attach it with plasticine.

- *...I attached the eyes and now I am going to attach the nose. Say: I am going to attach the nose to the hedgehog. Would you like to stick a nose to the hedgehog? Look at this nose.*
- *Touch it. What does it feel like? It is cotton. Say: the nose is cotton. Here we have another one! It is a pompom. Say: it is a pompom.*
- *Which one do you like? Say: May I have this nose please. Here you are.*
- *Now we are going to stick prickles to the hedgehog. Look at all these prickles. What colour are these prickles? Say: "They are brown".*
- *Touch them. What do they feel like? Look, this one is smooth, and this one is furry. Which pair of prickles do you like the most? Say: I prefer these prickles. (To another child: Say: I would like these prickles.)*

Show them a finished version of the craft if needed. Do not forget to compliment kids (Well done!) and sign the works.

- *Now let's put our crafts to dry.*

0. Materials:

- Several options of eyes: wiggle eyes, buttons, beads, printed and felt eyes
- Glue sticks
- Clear glue
- Double-sided tape
- Painting instruments: brushes, foam plastic rollers, sponges, prickly balls, pipe cleaners, stamps, clothes pegs with pieces of foil, paper, cotton balls, etc.
- Decorations: glitter, sequins, etc.
- Foamirane, felt, foamed polypropylene, cardboard, corrugated cardboard, cloth, velvet paper, texture cardboard, construction paper, foil, etc.
