

Adding SCORM Packages to Canvas

SCORM packages can be added to Canvas to provide additional activities for students to participate in.

SCORM Packages in Canvas

Add SCORM Navigation Item to Canvas


- 1. Open the Canvas course that you would like to add the SCORM package into.
- 2. On the left-hand course Navigation menu, scroll down to the bottom and click "Settings."



3. In the top menu, click on "Navigation."



- 4. Locate the SCORM item in the disabled applications and drag it towards the top of the screen to enable it as an application.
 - a. You can move your navigation items around by dragging them or using the ellipses on the right hand side of the navigation item.



- 5. Once SCORM has been enabled, scroll to the bottom of the screen and click the Save button.
 - a. If you do not click the Save button and navigate out of the page you will need to redo this process.





Uploading SCORM Package

These steps are to be performed after the SCORM navigation item has been added to a Canvas Course.

Note: If your SCORM package will not upload to the course because it is too large, you will need to <u>submit a ticket to the Learning Experience Environments team to request additional storage space in your Canvas course.</u>

1. Click on the SCORM item in the left-hand course navigation bar of the Canvas course.



2. To upload a new SCORM package, click on the "Upload" button in the top right-hand corner.

- 3. Locate the SCORM package on your computer, and click "Done" to begin the upload process.
- 4. When the upload process is complete, the SCORM package will be available on the screen.
- 5. Canvas provides multiple options for presenting SCORM packages:
 - a. Embedded in a page.
 - b. Graded assignment.
 - c. Non-graded assignment.

Presenting SCORM Items

SCORM in a Canvas Page


1. Make sure that the SCORM package has successfully uploaded.




2. To the right of the SCORM package name, click on "Choose import type..."



3. In the drop-down menu, choose "Import as page"




4. To add the page to a module, click on the Modules navigation item in the left-hand course navigation panel.



- 5. Choose the module you want to add the page to.
- 6. In the module, click on the plus sign (+) to the right-hand side of the module.



7. Select "Page" from the dropdown menu.

- 8. Find the name of the SCORM package in the list.
- 9. Once you have found it, click on it and select "Add item" in the bottom corner.
- 10. The page will appear at the bottom of the module.
 - a. You may move the page using the dots to the left-hand side of the item name and drag the item where you would like it in the module.
- 11. If the page is not yet published, make sure to publish it before providing it for students. The circle will turn green once the item is published.




SCORM as an Assignment

- 1. Make sure that the SCORM package has successfully uploaded.
- 2. To the right of the SCORM package name, click on "Choose import type..."




- 3. In the drop-down menu, choose "Import as graded assignment" or "Import as ungraded assignment."
 - a. The graded option will create a grade column in the Canvas gradebook and will provide points to students based on activities within the presentation.
 - b. The ungraded option will not provide students with a grade for completing activities within the presentation.






4. To add the assignment to a module, click on the Modules navigation item in the left-hand course navigation panel.



- 5. Choose the module you want to add the page to.
- 6. In the module, click on the plus sign (+) to the right-hand side of the module.



7. Select "Assignment" from the dropdown menu.




- 8. Find the name of the SCORM package in the list.
- 9. Once you have found it, click on it and select "Add item" in the bottom corner.
- 10. The page will appear at the bottom of the module.
 - a. You may move the page using the dots to the left-hand side of the item name and drag the item where you would like it in the module.



11. You may edit the assignment by clicking into it and selecting "Edit Assignment Settings" in the upper-right corner of the screen.



12. In the assignment settings you may edit the assignment to include a description, differing point value, submission attempts, and assign (assign to, due dates, available from and until).





13. When you are done, click Save and Publish to make it available within the module.
