What inspired I Like Mic?

I've been using Vision Pro since its launch for work, and in all this time I've wondered why you couldn't use your device's microphone with Mac apps via Mac Virtual Display.

Well, I don't wonder any more, because I am now fully aware of the technical hurdles to make that happen. I believe I've overcome most if not all of them with I Like Mic and its optional companion utility app for the Mac.

What if I don't have a Mac or use Mac Virtual Display?

No Mac? No problem! I Like Mic is a standalone voice recording app. Unlike the default app for voice recording, I Like Mic features:

- A soundboard with 4 sound effects that you can play in real time with your voice while recording
 - Ability to change sound level of your microphone and soundboard effects from 0 to 200%
 - Ability to export your recording in M4A, WAV or AIFF format

What if I want to stream both my Persona and my audio to the Mac? For example, to use in Zoom, Teams or other virtual meeting apps?

I use Persona Webcam, and for me it works great on visionOS 26 and macOS 26.

I Like Mic is the missing link to get streaming audio from the device's microphone to Mac Virtual Display. They work great together! (I use both every day for work.)

Why do I have to leave the I Like Mic app window open to stream to Mac?

I can't keep the audio stream open while the visionOS app is backgrounded.

If someone has figured out a workaround, please contact me.

Why isn't the Mac app in the Mac App Store? Seems weird to download it from Github.

I know, right? Unfortunately, getting streaming from Vision Pro to Mac Virtual Display to work requires “a pathway to many abilities some consider to be unnatural” (Emperor Palpatine’s words, not mine).

Anyway, without getting too technical, this is a universal limitation to all Mac apps that require access to virtual audio drivers. They can’t be published in the Mac App Store.

(Don’t get me started on why a camera with audio can be properly sandboxed, but audio on its own cannot...)

On the plus side, I Like Mic for Mac is notarized by Apple, and most important for you, free to download to use with the visionOS version of I Like Mic.
