New Conduct Policy [*Amended 18MAR2022*] Starting: Second Semester 2021 - 2022

The key to this policy is: "Let the conduct do the work"

There will no longer be any suspensions apart from HUGE problems. All students are aware of what conduct marks are given for what conduct infractions. A list of the -20 (major incidents) are given on the second page of this document.

If a student's conduct drops below 75%, they will be suspended 1 day. The parents will be informed of this suspension by a WhatsApp message.

If the student's conduct drops below 60%, they will be suspended a further 1 day.

If the student's conduct drops below 50%, they will be suspended a further 1 day.

If the student's conduct drops below 40%, they will be suspended a further 1 day.

If the student's conduct drops below 30%, they will be suspended a further 1 day.

If the student's conduct drops below 20%, they will be suspended a further 1 day.

If the student's conduct drops below 10%, they will be suspended a further 1 day.

If the student's conduct drops to 0%, they will be excluded until the end of the term.

Conduct Punishments
