

Q: What is MD Camp?

A: MD Camp is an intensive, three-week summer day camp providing participants an experience in the rigors of medical school. For more information about the MD Camp and the curriculum, please visit our official website: [MD Camp at Ohio State](#)

Q: When is the 2026 MD Camp?

A: The dates for the 2026 MD Camp are June 8th, 2026 to June 26th, 2026. The camp will run from 8 A.M - 4:30 P.M. on weekdays at The Ohio State University College of Medicine, with June 19th off in observance of Juneteenth.

Q: Who can apply to MD Camp?

A: MD Camp is open to rising sophomores, juniors and seniors in high school. We will not accept applications from rising freshmen or graduating seniors.

Q: Do I have to be from Ohio to apply to MD Camp?

A: Yes, your permanent address must be in Ohio and you must be an Ohio Resident.

Q: How long will the application be open?

A: The MD Camp application will be open until March 17th, 2026 @ 11:59 P.M.

Q: Will late applications be accepted?

A: To be fair to all of our applicants, we will not be accepting any applications received after the deadline of March 17th, 2026. This includes both the complete written application as well as the receipt of all recommendation letters and resume.

Q: How many letters of recommendation are required?

A: We require 2 letters of recommendation.

Q: Who can write my letters of recommendation?

A: Letters of recommendations can be written by someone who can speak to your educational performance, skills, personal qualities, and any achievements. This can include but is not limited to: teachers, bosses/managers/supervisors, coaches, counselors, and advisors. ***At least one of these letters must be written by a math or science teacher.*** Letters of recommendation cannot be written by family members.

Q: How do I submit letters of recommendation and when are they due?

A: Letters must be submitted by your recommenders via this link: [MD Camp 2026 Letter of Recommendation Form](#). This link is also provided on the application and official MD Camp website. Letters are due the same day as applications (March 17th, 2026 at 11:59 P.M.). No late letters will be accepted. Failure to have letters submitted will result in your application being incomplete and not reviewed.

Q: I submitted my application, but I did not receive a confirmation email. Does that mean you have not received my application?

A: No email confirmations are sent out upon receipt of a submitted application. Instead, once your application has been submitted, a screen saying "Your response has been recorded" will appear.

Q: When will we find out if we are selected for MD Camp?

A: After the application closes, we will be conducting interviews in April. If you are chosen for an interview, we will email you at the email address you provide on your application. We will send out final decisions for accepted applicants in May following the conclusion of all interviews.

Q: Will housing be provided if I wish to attend MD Camp but reside out of town?

A: Unfortunately, because MD Camp is a day camp, we cannot provide room and board for students, and students must leave campus at the end of camp each day. If you live farther away, you will be responsible for securing housing for the duration of camp. Students are also responsible for their own transportation to and from camp.

Q: What if I have another commitment taking place during MD Camp?

A: Campers are expected to attend each day of camp, as the curriculum builds upon itself as the camp progresses.

Q: How much will tuition cost?

A: Tuition will cost approximately \$325. Applicants can be awarded full or partial scholarships based on financial need and quality of application.

Q: Are immunizations required?

A: No.
