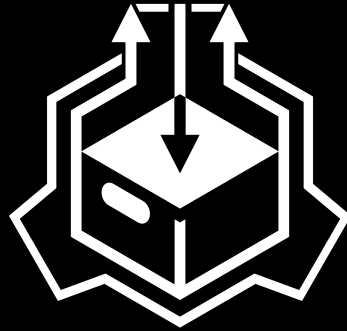

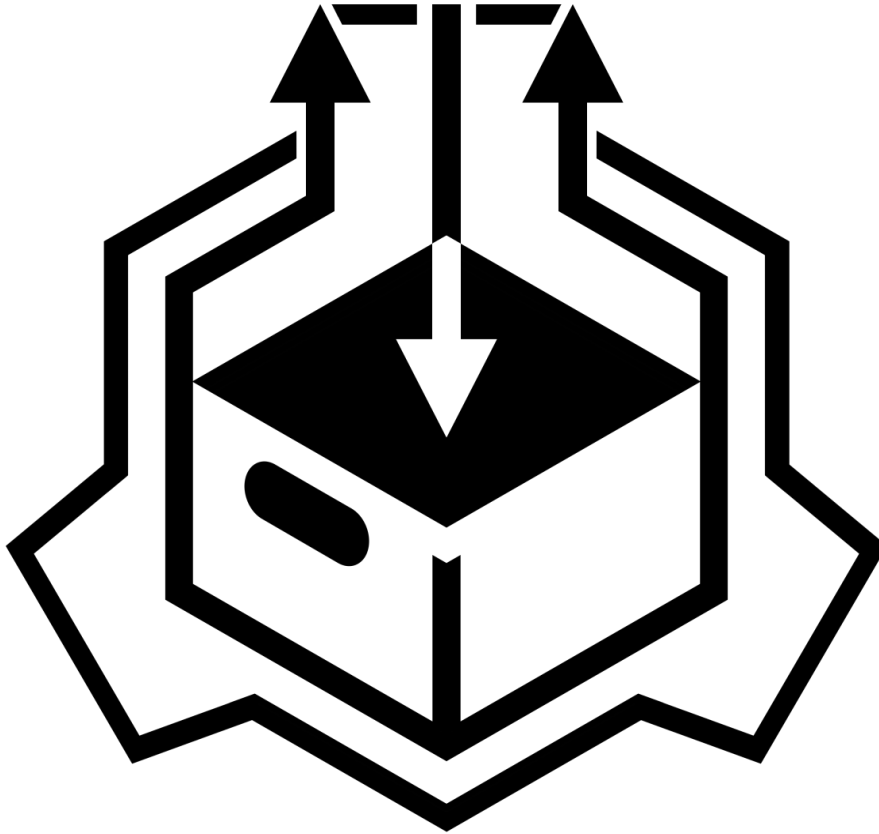

[SECTION 1 - PSYCHOLOGICAL PROFILE]

JENKINS, M. presents an anomalous psychological profile consistent with the Foundation Ethics Committee eligibility criteria. JENKINS demonstrates a pronounced capacity for moral absolutism tempered, comparably by a documented tolerance for institutional ambiguity - a combination rarely observed in candidates under the age of 35.

Standardised Ethical Reasoning Assessment V23.5 (ERA-23) [MJ-02] score: 97th percentile. Of particular note is JENKINS performance on the Trolley Problem Battery (Extended), in which he selected options that deviated from both utilitarian and moral frameworks in 4 of 12 scenarios, instead articulating what reviewing psychologists have termed a "situationally emergent moral conscience." This was flagged as either exceptional insight or early-stage psychotic behaviour.

Note: Follow-up testing inconclusive.

Trauma Markers WARNING:

- JENKINS presents as a non-verbal Foundation employee. Personal incidents regarding [REDACTED] from an incident on ██/██/██ induced JENKINS to become mute.
- JENKINS presents a reliance on a small bladed article on his person at all times. Attempts to remove this blade caused.. problematic for psychologist [REDACTED]
 - Note: Unconfirmed reports of JENKINS speaking have been submitted, however not corroborated.
- Empathy index: HIGH.
- Compliance index: MODERATE.

- Capacity for sanctioning D-Class termination procedures: [UNDER REVIEW].

[SECTION 2 - RECRUITMENT HISTORY]

JENKINS was identified at age █ during a routine talent-monitoring sweep of [REDACTED] University's philosophy department. At the time, JENKINS had submitted an undergraduate dissertation titled "The Ethics of Knowing What Cannot Be Unseen: Moral Obligations in Information Management." The dissertation was flagged by an embedded Foundation asset, (Senior Agent █) as demonstrating an intuitive understanding of SCP-adjacent ethical frameworks with no prior exposure to classified or Foundation material.

Initial contact was made 2-weeks later under the guise of a [REDACTED] Research Fellowship at Site-█. Subject accepted within 72 hours. Standard amnestic protocols were held in reserve if JENKINS proved unsuitable for Foundation working. Following a 6-month probationary observation period embedded within Site-█'s administrative wing, JENKINS was formally briefed on the Foundation's nature and mission.

Notably, JENKINS recorded response upon full briefing [MJ-01] was: "I had a feeling it was something like this." This response has been preserved in Addendum MJ-01 and is considered [LOW-LEVEL ANOMALOUS] *pending further investigation.* [MJ-04]

[SECTION 3 - NOTABLE RULINGS & COMMENDATIONS]

EC-RULING-2024-041

Dissented against proposed reclassification of SCP-█ located on Site-█ from Euclid to Keter. Dissent upheld. Subsequent containment breach averted. Commendation issued by Site Director █.

EC-RULING-2024-089

Successfully argued for suspension of Experiment Log █-E on SCP-█ on humanitarian grounds. The ruling was overturned by O5 command within 48 hours. Incident classified. JENKINS was not notified of the ruling's reversal until █ weeks later. JENKINS emotional response was noted as "disproportionate" by a supervising Ethics Committee senior.

COMMENDATION - 2025

Recipient of the Foundation Internal Ethics Medal (Second Class) for conduct during the [REDACTED] Incident.

Citation reads: "Demonstrated exceptional moral clarity under conditions that would compromise the judgment of more experienced personnel." Supervising officer's private annotation: "He's 21. He still thinks we're the good guys. Don't tell him yet."

[SECTION 4 - MEDICAL & SECURITY NOTES]

"Upon physical evaluation on █/█/2025 on entering Site-█ Jenkins showed concern for physical deterioration. Being a non-verbal Foundation personnel also proved difficult to perform the evaluation."

"Blood work from Jenkins shows a genetic abnormality in which his body will at some point or other begin to degrade and lose his senses. The only way to delay this eventual detriment is to begin treatment under Medical SCP, SCP-█ in which Jenkins will be given 1 SCP-█ per week."

"Attempted assessments to 'cure' Jenkins' non-verbalness has proved tough and unsuccessful. Without further access to his RESTRICTED records, I am unable to evaluate this further"

INCIDENT LOG S-█-M1211 [MJ-03]

"Jenkins was referred to Doctor ████████ for a psychological evaluation standard for all Foundation personnel. Dr. ████████ insisted no weapons were to be in the confines of their office. Upon insistence to remove the weapon, Dr. ████████ physically attempted to remove the weapon herself. CCTV shows Jenkins instinctively 'defending' himself and stabbing Dr. ████████. Interference on playback of the CCTV prevented any further evaluation of the events. Senior Ethics Committee Member [REDACTED] insisted Jenkins acted in self-defence and the investigation was closed."

[SECTION 5 - SUPERVISORY NOTES]

"Jenkins is, without question, the most ethically principled member of this Committee. He is also, without question, the most naïve. These two facts are not unrelated. He still believes containment exists to protect the anomalies as much as the public. He still asks whether D-Class personnel have families. He still flinches at the phrase 'acceptable losses.'"

"He is, in short, exactly what the Ethics Committee was designed to be. We filed the paperwork to keep him. We are beginning to wonder if we should have."

"Jenkins being, 21, shows somewhat deferential to institutional authority. He pushes back on rulings, but is unlikely to go rogue. He has no connections, leverage and is yet to turn cynical. The optics for The Committee, having a principled young voice works wonders while we retain control over him"

"Recommend continued monitoring. Do not expose to SCP-█, SCP-█."

"Jenkins is in possession of a bladed weapon on his person at all times. Personnel hear 'whispers' whenever he walks by them - Recommended for investigation to Research Director ████████."

[SECTION 6 - Elevation to Committee Notes]

JENKINS elevation to that of The Ethics Committee at the age of 21 proved debatable within The Committee. According to Desensitisation Study RS-231, older experienced researchers were deemed "unviable" and desensitised after signing off enough D-Class expenditures and incident reports. JENKINS scoring in the 97th percentile in the ERA-23 proved near clairvoyance status, confirming his anomalous capabilities.
