- Incoming 9th graders will receive their schedule during Link Crew on August 10th. All 10-12th graders will receive their schedule during Advisory on August 10th.
- Students who have enrolled in Advanced Placement (AP) courses, your summer assignments are due on the first day of school.
- I have included a list of important dates for the next school year, please put the dates in your calendar and put that document on your refrigerator.
- Some changes have been made to our service learning program. Service Learning is not simply community service but instead, a mutually beneficial relationship between student and an organization in their community. We hope that students will gain experience in a career field they want to explore and that they will learn the value in giving back to their community. Students will be required to complete 72 hours of Service Learning in at least four different placements or organizations to graduate. Advisors will need to approve the placement before the student completes the service. Students will need to take an [evaluation form](#) with them for their supervisor to complete at the end of the service. All of this information will now be logged in the Service Learning portal of Aeries.

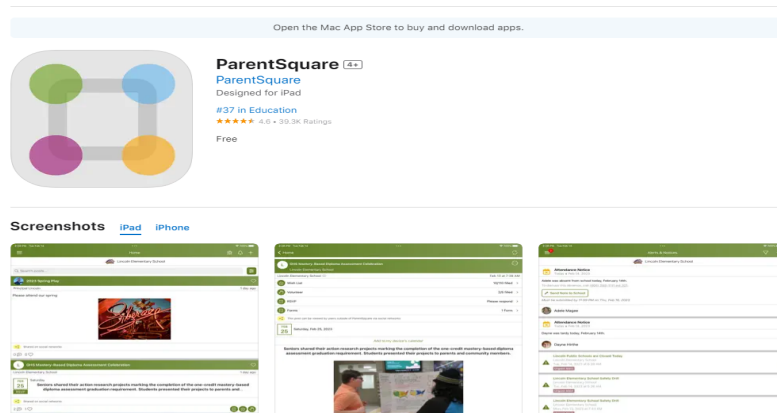
