What is OwnPath Profile?

OwnPath Profile is a tool that allows behavioral health providers across Colorado to update and maintain their information on [OwnPath Care Directory](#), BHA's publicly accessible web-based search platform.

Why did BHA build OwnPath Profile?

OwnPath Profile enables us to expand both the quality and volume of behavioral health provider data that is available, both to the public and to BHA. OwnPath Profile reduces provider burden by giving providers a single location for data input.

Who will use OwnPath Profile?

BHA licensed and non-BHA licensed providers who provide behavioral health services in Colorado. Admin or non-clinical staff will use the system to update operational information about their clinic or organization.

Highlights

- Providers manage their own data and can update it in real time. They have control on how their facility is displayed to the public.
- Providers can update operational information (e.g. phone numbers, hours) as well as quality of care information people rely on when searching for care (e.g. accessibility support, languages spoken, communities served).
- BHA will provide human Spanish translation to maintain parity on [MiPropiaSenda.co](#) (the Spanish version of OwnPath Care Directory).

Compliance requirements

BHASO network providers are required to review and update their facility information once every three months. This is to ensure that information available on OwnPath Care Directory is up to date and accurate for people seeking care.
