

2024 Pine Grove MS Scholastic Chess Open Saturday, April 6

This tournament is open to all scholastic chess players grades K-12 in Central New York, including eligible home-schooled students.

There will be 2 sections: **Grades K-5 and 6-12!** Each section will have 4 rounds with no elimination. All players play 4 games. Please tell Bob Nasiff if you must leave early.

Awards: Trophies to the top 4 players and top 2 teams in each section. Chess Medals will be awarded to all players in both sections who score at least 3 points and don't win a trophy.

This is an individual event (not team on team). Team awards are based on the combined scores of the top-2-5 players from each school. Schools can enter as many players as they wish per team.

Schedule: 1st round will start at 10:30 am. We expect this event to end around 3 pm.

½ Point Byes: Players wishing to participate but are unable to attend all 4 games, we can allot ½ point byes for games you miss, as long as we are notified in advance which rounds you are unable to attend.

Entry fees: \$10. Players on teams of 6 or more players: \$9 each. \$15 for those registering late on 4/6. Entry fees must be paid on-site during check-in. Cash or check made out to **Robert Nasiff.**

Check-in: 9-10 am including late registrants! **We need everyone, including teams, to be checked in no later than 10 am. Please make arrangements to arrive early enough to do so!**

Team rosters: must be submitted no later than Friday 4/5. Roster changes +/- will be allowed on Saturday morning 4/6 **before** 10 am. Team entry fees must be collected by coaches or team supervisors, and turned in together with completed team rosters.
