Students must submit an ADN (Evening) program application to the Health Sciences Admissions Coordinator between September 1st and February 1st for consideration of admission in the following fall semester (August). To be eligible for an NUR ADN Evening/Weekend option application, the student must meet the following criteria:

- All non-NUR prefix curriculum coursework must be completed by the 2027 fall semester end for possible fall semester 2028 acceptance
- The student's overall grade point average must be 2.0 or higher
- Students must demonstrate current certification on the North Carolina Nurse Aide I Registry.

A minimum grade of “C” is required for **non-NUR courses**, and a minimum grade of “B” is required for **NUR courses**
