Google Classroom

- Return **all work** to students
- (optional) Create a template (or copy) of) each class: All of your assignments, materials, and topics will be in draft form waiting to be posted for next year!
- Archive your classes: You can still reuse posts from archived classes; they will not appear on your (or your students') Classroom main page!

- If you want to keep your classes, you need to remove the students from the class!

Archive your classes

You only need to archive classes you <u>created</u>, **not** classes created with Clever (If you see the blue "C" you do not have to archive the class).

- All posts and messages are automatically archived on 07/04/2023. IF you want to keep copies of messages, the easiest way is to copy/paste your information into a Google Doc for safekeeping.




