After about a 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ years of use on our Splendide 2100XC (Purchased August 2010), the last 6-8 months we started noticing a longer dry time. (Normal dry time was 60 minutes, eventually 80, 100, then max) Finally the display lights started flashing rapidly and it stopped drying. I emailed them for help, I put this in step by step form for my benefit. My first try I did not get the water level high enough and it only worked a few weeks. I emailed them back and they stressed that the water level must half fill the drum (don't worry, it won't leak out).

- 1. Empty washer
- 2. Set dry time to off
- 3. Set wash cycle to #11 (I add 1/2 cup of bleach on the first cycle only)
- 4. Press and release start, don't get too far, you're not done yet.
- 5. When water stops entering drum, push and hold the start button until green lights come on then go off, then release.
 - 6. Press and release the start button again, water will begin filling (second fill).
- 7. When water stops entering drum, push and hold the start button until green lights come on and go off, then release.
 - 8. Move the selector to cycle #2
 - 9. Press and release the extra rinse button
- 10. Press and release the start button (third fill) and let it run this cycle. Water level should be at $\frac{1}{2}$ drum.
- 11. When washer stops, clean the lint out of the drum and repeat steps 2 more times (Total of 3 cycles, each cycle takes approximately 1 hour 45 min).
