1. Finances - Rhianna

139 people at camp

16 5-day tickets, 64 workers

34 adult full ticket, 25 children

Surplus £5,000 - slightly less income than last year, more workers

Investment in water area, mainly the stove

Higher cost for recycling, glass in the general waste!

Café slight profit, bar broke even

Likely to be liable for tax on the profit

Action: remind people about recycling

2. Wellbeing area - Anna

Good year, superb team of 15

At least 71 1:1 sessions, good take-up of group sessions

Tea tent was broken, large tent for massage needed to replace Ziggy's old tent

Repairs to the rectangular white tent with windows that used to be repeat bar as it leaks.

Ideally a large round canvas tent for tea tent, like a bell tent if possible and it can be put away and stored dry

Need another massage table

Dance church in main programme if possible

Gate marquee is drafty and has lots of holes

Some tents were not properly secured, leading to damage in the wind

Action: investigate replacement covering for frames and new tents

3. Café – Amy

Good team, but could have delegated more

Re-usable containers worked well

Need a new cooking hob as the old one is leaky

Better recycling system needed

Tea and coffee in the morning was well received

Hygiene is not great is wash-up area, embarrassing for visitors

Action: equipment needs sorting as we don't use all of it

4. Site - Tony

Good early start on Friday

Some issues with securing tents, site crew do know that pegs are available

Pack-down was good

Action: ensure that all structures are well secured

5. Water - Rumi

Good team

Kit for showers makes it easier to dismantle

Cubicles could be improved, with shower curtains

Action: gas boiler for main marquee, or a stock pot on a gas ring

6. Toilets - Bill

Happy to have a crew to manage the toilets

One seat is broken and needs repair

Action: non-slip tape for steps
