This fictitious diary of a twelve year old girl in 1924 in Mocksville contains clippings and illustrations to verify the events she experiences and describes.

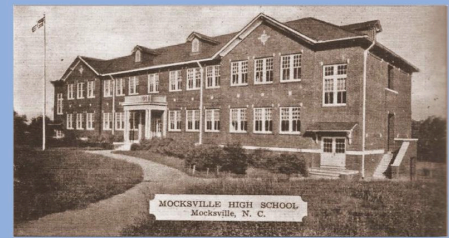
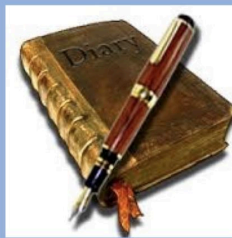
