

#StoryLink Connections

Purpose: To make connections and build storytelling links with others in our schools, families, and beyond.

Goal: Connect with as many people as you can virtually and face-to-face to help begin a story. Their job is to write the first sentence of a story that you will then finish.

Tasks: There will be 4 main ways to connect:

1. Social Media

- Use the script below to post on your social media. Change the wording wherever necessary but make sure to use the #StoryLink and describe what they need to do:
 - Hey y'all! I'm doing a story project for school called #StoryLink. I need the first sentence for a story and we'll write a story based on YOUR first sentence! Put your sentence in the comments below!

2. Email

- Use the script below to email people:
 - Hello! I'm doing a story project for school called #StoryLink. I need the first sentence for a story and we'll write a story based on YOUR first sentence! Please email me back a first sentence.

3. Classroom Board

- Have someone you know or don't know come in our classroom and write a sentence, or create a sentence using some of the magnetic words. This will need to be done **before or after school, during the change of classes, or during lunch**.
- Optional: Take a selfie of yourself with the person and the sentence and post it to social media. Don't forget to use the hashtag #StoryLink!

4. Take a Picture with a Person and the Sentence

- Or have the person write the sentence down on paper and take a picture of the person with the paper. Then turn the paper in to Ms. Bartell.

Requirement: You must connect with at least 3 different people face-to-face. TWO of these people should be someone you do not know well. **Please do not approach strangers in public unless you have permission from an accompanying adult.**
