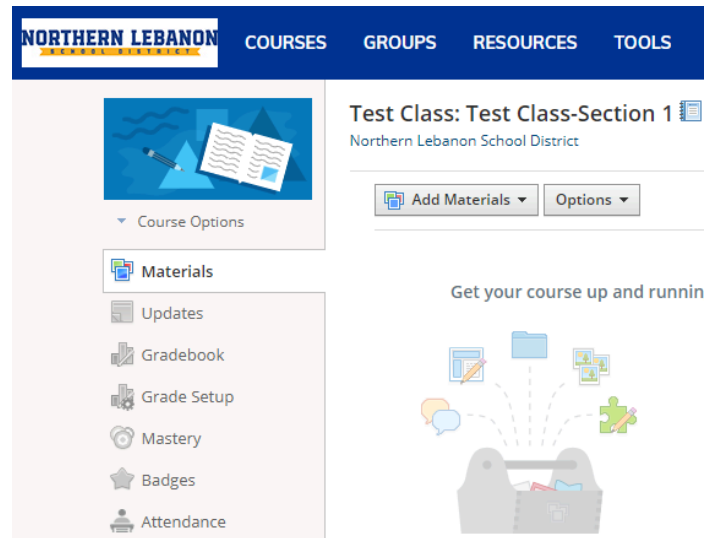


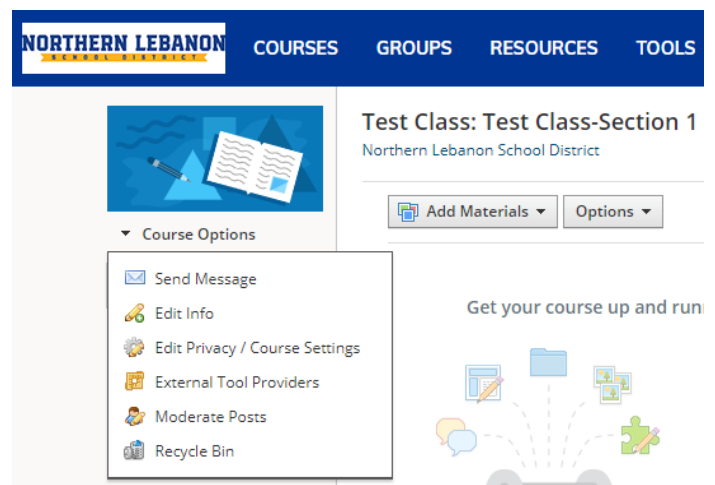
## Schoology-Change a Course Theme

Schoology supports two different course themes: a default “Secondary” theme for older students, and a simpler “Elementary” theme for elementary level students. You can change the theme for a single course to make the interface easier to use. You must be an admin in the course to make this change. Follow these steps to change the course theme:

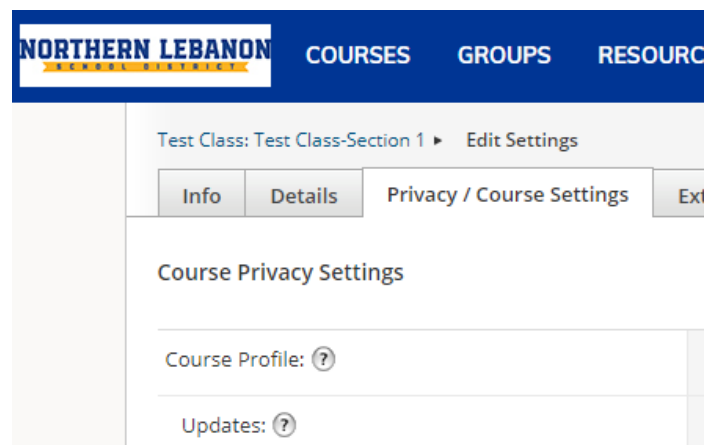
1. Login to Schoology and access a course.



2. On the left menu, click on **Course Options**, then choose **Edit Privacy / Course Settings**.



3. On the **Privacy / Course Settings** menu, scroll to the bottom of the screen and look for **Course View Settings**.



4. Under **Course View Settings**, find the **Course Theme** setting.

5. Choose the Course Theme that is appropriate for the course. Then click the **Save Changes** button.
