- 1. Mat 14:22 Immediately Jesus made His disciples get into the boat and go before Him to the other side, while He sent the multitudes away.
- 2. Mark 6:7 Jesus summoned the twelve and began to send them out two by two, giving them authority over unclean spirits
- 3. John 1:.6 There was a man sent from God whose name was John.
- 4. James 2:25 Likewise also was not Rahab the harlot justified by works, when she had received the messengers, and had sent them out another way.
- 5. 1 John 4:4 And we have seen and do testify that the Father sent the Son to be the Savior of the world.

- 6. Hebrews 1:14 Are they not all ministering spirits sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation.
- 7. John 20:21 AMP- Then Jesus said to them again, "Peace to you; as the Father has sent Me, I also send you [as My representatives]."
- 8. Matthew 10:1 Jesus called his twelve disciples to him and gave them authority to drive out impure spirits and to heal every disease and sickness. Matthew 10:5 These twelve Jesus sent out with the following instructions: "Do not go among the Gentiles or enter any town of the Samaritans.
