How will students register?

Students in grades 9-11 will register during 1st block classes with school counselors.

Any student who does not have a 1st block class will be locked into an AllTimely session with a counselor to complete their registration.

- Graduation Requirements

CONTENT AREA	CREDITS (28 TO GRADUATE)	SPECIFIC COURSES REQUIRED
English	4	English I, II, III, IV
Math	4	NC Math 1, 2, 3, and a 4th level Math • 4th Math Option varies by post graduation goals
Social Studies	4	World History, American History, Economics and Personal Finance, Civic Literacy
Science	3	Earth/Environmental Science Physical Science (Options include Physical Science, Chemistry or Physics) Biology
Health & PE	1	Health & PE
Electives	12	Student can participate in electives from multiple areas (Career and Technical Education (CTE), Arts, JROTC, etc.)
*World Language	0	*Not a graduation requirement, however, NC public universities and most four-year colleges highly recommend two world language credits

- If a student plans to attend a 4 year college directly after high school, they will need Math 4 or higher.

- Grades and teacher recommendations are considered for students who are interested in Honors or AP classes.
- Students should choose courses based on interest in the course and/or college/career goals.
- Students must take and pass the previous course in order to move to the next level of the course. (Ex. Must pass Foods I to take Foods II, must pass Spanish I to take Spanish II, etc.)
- WJHS Counselors reserve the right to make changes to ensure graduation requirements are met and as need dictates based on the master schedule. Changes to the Johnston County Public Schools 2025-2026 budget may affect the number and variety of courses offered next school year. It is possible that courses listed on the registration form may NOT be offered depending on the final budget and staffing.

Schedule Change Information:

Every effort will be made to ensure students have the courses that meet their graduation requirements and college/career interests. We realize students may want to make changes. However, we are limited in what changes we can accommodate:

Examples of VALID schedule changes

- Student needs a course to meet graduation requirements
- Student has a hole in their schedule
- Student wants Honors/AP classes
- Student does not have a prerequisite for a schedule class
- Student is scheduled for a class they already passed
- Student has a conflict with CCP classes
- Student wants Late Arrival or Early Release (seniors only)

Examples of INVALID schedule changes

- Changing a class because of teacher preference
- To have classes with friends
- To change electives that were selected during course registration because they are no longer interested
- To have a class during a different time
