Northeast Iowa Community College recognizes prior learning by accepting a full range of Advanced Placement (AP) examinations. The American Council on Education (ACE) and the College Board recommend that colleges and universities award credit for AP scores of 3 or higher on any AP Examination.

NICC will grant a total of 42 credits for successful performance on AP examinations.
