What to expect at Motion 2022



Cost and Payment Deadlines

Total Motion 2022 x Thrive Students cost is \$390. This is applied to and covers <u>all</u> camp costs. Checks made out to Thrive Church, with your student's name in the memo and turned into Taia.

Payment Deadlines

- Wed. April 27, 2022 Deposit of \$195 is due to secure registration and give the green light to Thrive Church to purchase airline tickets.
- Wed. June 1, 2022 Remaining \$195 is due.

Travel Information

Dates

July 28 to July 31, 2022 (Conference is July 28-30th and July 31st is the return travel day)

Flights

All Thrive Students and Leaders will travel to camp together. Students will be allowed carry-on bags/duffle bags only (no checked baggage). Motion 2022 begins at 7p on Jul. 28, so we will fly out the morning of Jul. 28th. The return flight will be on Sunday, July 31st, 2022.

Flights will be purchased following registration and deposit due on April 27th. Once flights are finalized, pick-up and drop-off times from Thrive Church will be communicated at the Mandatory Parent/Guardian Meeting on May 22, 2022.

Meals

All meals are included in the camp cost of \$390.

During camp days, boxed meals will be delivered directly to our Thrive Students group. Each boxed meal includes an entrée, side, dessert, and water. Past vendors include: Chick-fil-A, Newk's Eatery, and Jim N' Nicks. Gluten friendly meals are available but are unable to accommodate any other food allergies or special requests in meal orders. Please make sure to mark gluten-free on your registration if these accommodations are needed. Additionally, there will be a variety of food options available for additional purchase at concession stands throughout the BJCC property if you desire additional meals or snacks. Prices vary.

Outside of camp days, we will have 4 fast-casual meals during travel for lunch and/or dinner. Breakfast and snack foods will be purchased by Leaders when we arrive for students to choose from and enjoy each morning.

Transportation

Passenger vans will be rented for transportation of all students. Thrive Students Leaders will be driving vans who have undergone and passed background checks, including motor vehicle records.

FAQs

I'm entering middle school in the fall of 2022, can I attend summer camp?

YES. Motion 2022 x Thrive Students is for all students 6th-12th grade for the 2022-2023 school year.

What is required to go?

Students must register and turn in the first payment of \$195 by April 27th. All students who are registered and attending camp, plus at least one of their parents/guardians, must attend the Mandatory Parent/Guardian Meeting on May 22nd from 2-3p at Thrive Church. Final payment of the remaining \$195 is due June 1st.

Why Motion 2022 for summer camp?

Pastors Jacob and Hannah have known and been connected to the hosting church, Church of the Highlands, for over 10 years. It is a reputable church with incredible pastors and leaders. In addition, Pastors Jacob and Hannah are connected to the leader of the Student Ministries of Church of the Highlands, Mark Pettus. We are confident that this will not only be a life-changing, and powerful weekend, but also one that is safe, Bible-based, and Spirit-led. How does \$390 cover everything?

At Thrive Church, we believe there's a mandate on the house to reach the youth. We don't want finances to be the largest obstacle between students and an opportunity to encounter the presence of God. Therefore, through the generosity of finances, Thrive Church will be covering a large portion of the camp experience for each student to bridge the gap between the costs and what families will pay. It is our heart to keep camp affordable and extend this opportunity to as many students as possible.

What if I can't afford camp?

One reason we open registration early is to make it easier for families to send their students to summer camp by spreading the cost over several months. If you know you won't be able to afford summer camp at all, you may be eligible for financial assistance. If you think you'll need a partial scholarship to send your student, you'll want to wait to register your student and fill out this <u>scholarship application</u> first. Do you offer refunds?

After signing up for Motion 2022 x Thrive Students, your money is non-refundable. You may transfer your spot to someone else UNTIL June 1st, but please understand you are responsible for finding someone to transfer the spot to.

If I'd like to contribute to the scholarship fund, how do I do that?

Every single year, lives are changed at camp. We never want the cost of camp to be the reason students can't attend. Every donation means that more students can experience one of the best things we do all year long. The scholarship fund helps to bridge the gap between what Thrive Church invests in camp and what parents pay. It helps keep camp affordable and provides partial and full scholarships to students who would not be able to afford it.
